

Tracey Garbutt goes west for golds

Tracey Garbutt is Vancouver bound.

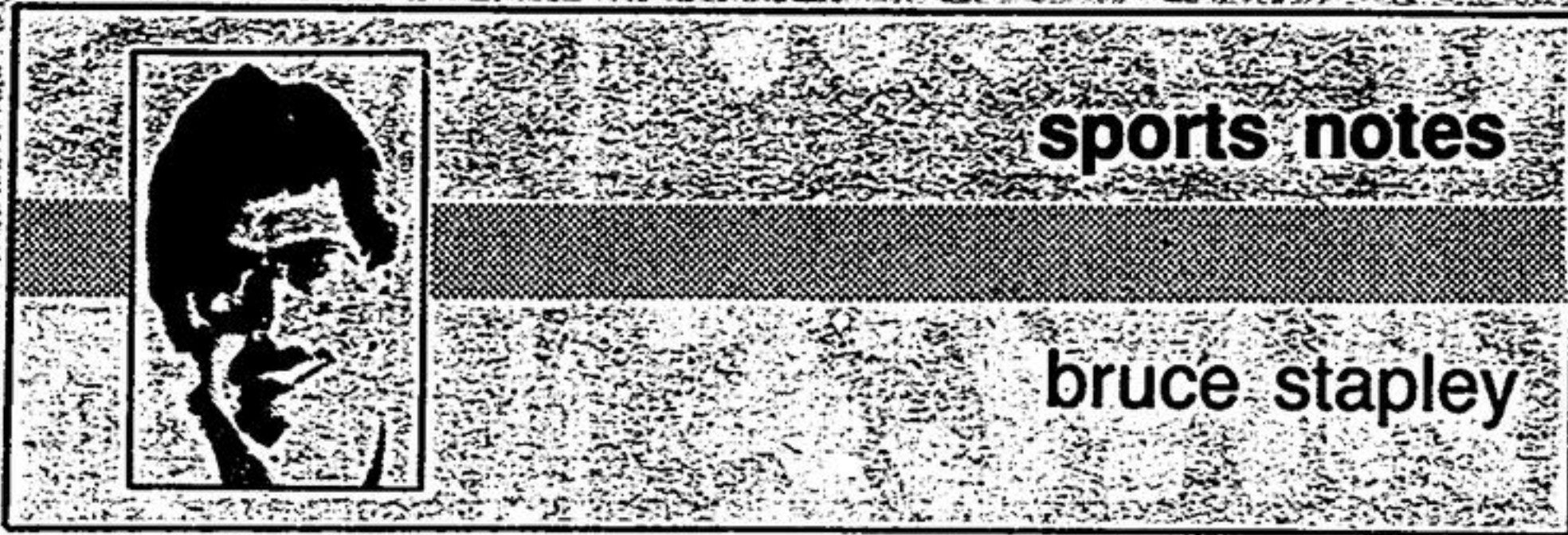
The 20-year-old Stouffville athlete was told last Tuesday she had made the Provincial team that will represent Ontario at the Canadian Special Olympics Summer Games next July in the British Columbia city.

It is the second time Tracey has earned the right to represent Ontario, the first being in 1986 when she won a gold and a silver medal when the games were held in Calgary.

Tracey qualified for next year's provincial team when she took a gold and two silver medals at the Ontario Special Games this August at York University.

Tracey's areas of specialization are the 100 and 400 metre sprint, and running long jump. She also competes in swimming and cross country ski events at the provincial level, but prefers track over the others in most high level competitions.

Tracey attends a Special Education class at Unionville High School, but according to her mother Michelle, needs something to keep her from getting bored. "Her involvement in running and swimming is the sort of outlet she needs," says

Michelle. And she is a fierce competitor. "She likes to win. She loves to be with the others, and to see new places, but she goes in it to do her best."

Tracey has been competing since she was 15, when a recreation co-ordinator for the York South Association for Community Living told her she should try her luck in the upcoming Ontario Special Olympics.

She had only three weeks to prepare, but apparently she reached fighting trim. She won a silver medal and three bronze medals that year in Burlington, which qualified her for the provincial team that competed in Calgary the next year.

In 1987, Tracey began swimming and cross country skiing competitively, and immediately

achieved results. She took a bronze in 100 metre cross country sprint in the Ontario Winter Games at Kapuskasing, then won

a gold in the summer version at Belleville.

This past year, the Association for Community Living provided her with a trainer, and she will have special training before making the trip to Vancouver next July.

She loves to ride horseback and skate, and she used to take ballet and gymnastics.

But come July, she'll be all business as she goes out to British Columbia in pursuit of more gold.
