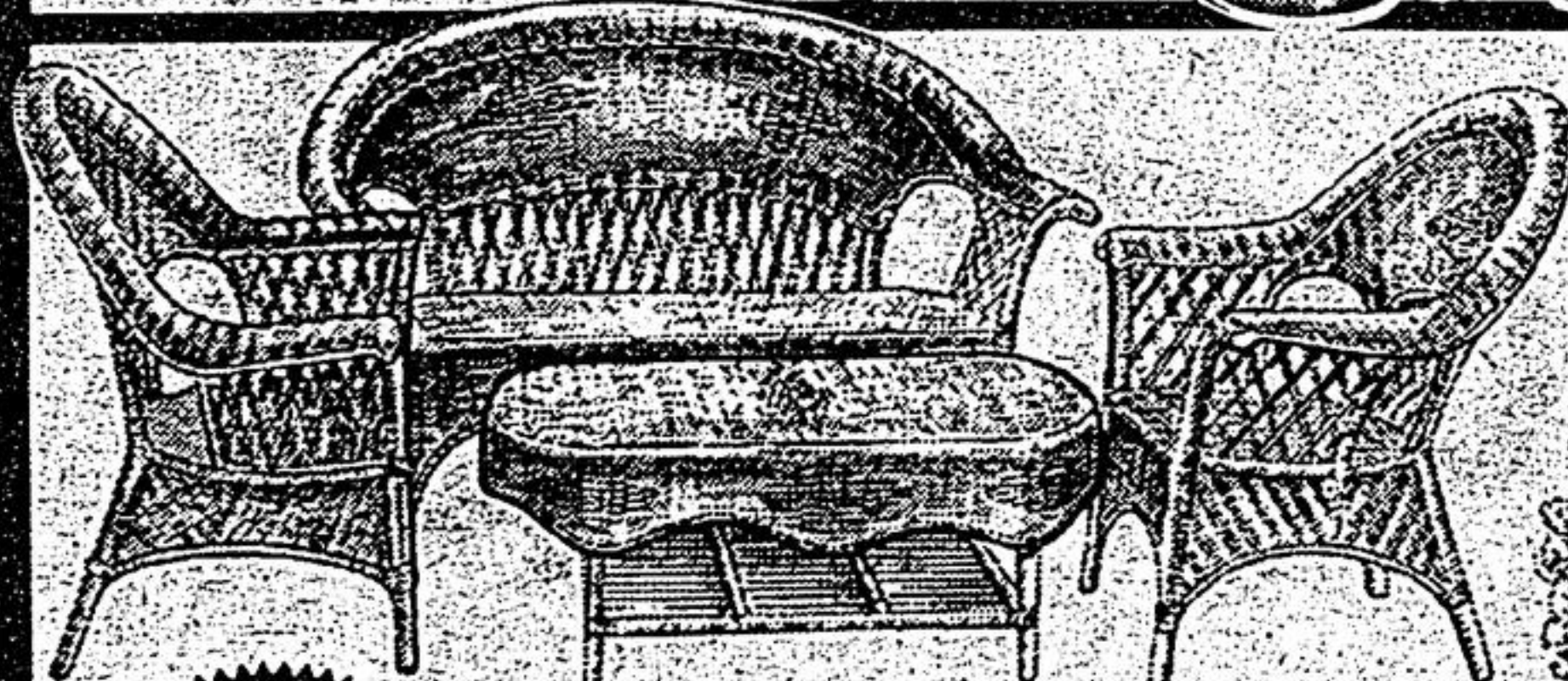

Durham schools skip to help Heart Foundation

Durham schools were a "skipping success" last year in helping raise funds for the Heart and Stroke Foundation of Ontario.

Fifty-four schools in the region participated last year in the Foundation's unique Jump Rope for Heart fitness program and raised \$224,000 for research and education, according to a release.

Durham students, along with others as far away as Big Trout Lake in Northern Ontario and a Canadian Forces school in West Germany, learned last year the importance of physical activity while also raising much-needed funds.

Through two-hour jump event fundraisers, students over-all collected pledges totalling \$3.1 million to fight heart disease.

Approximately 44 per cent of Ontario schools have taken part in Jump Rope for Heart campaigns since they were introduced in 1982, the release states. In 1988-89, 1,050 schools participated.

"We're really pleased with the growth of all facets of the pro-

gram," said Barb Horsman, provincial volunteer chairman of the Jump Rope for Heart program.

Police aim to reduce crime

York Regional Police is promoting higher awareness of crime prevention this week at a series of displays in York Region shopping centres.

A crime prevention display is being set up today and tomorrow at Hillcrest Mall in Richmond Hill, and at Markham's Markville Shopping Centre on Friday and Saturday.

Community Services Crime Prevention officers will be on hand to answer questions relating to crime prevention in the 1990s.

The displays include videos and self-help material to assist residents in protecting themselves and their homes or apartments from criminal acts.
