## Police checking for seat belts

York Regional Police laid 2,211 seat belt related charges in October as part of its month-long crackdown on seat belt neglect.

Police issued a statement last week releasing figures of the campaign. To date in York Region, 20 fatalities have been recorded in motor vehicle collisions.

Police say use of seat belts could reduce those numbers. "It is hoped that this campaign will heighten public awareness into the importance of the use of this simple and effective safety device," noted the release.
