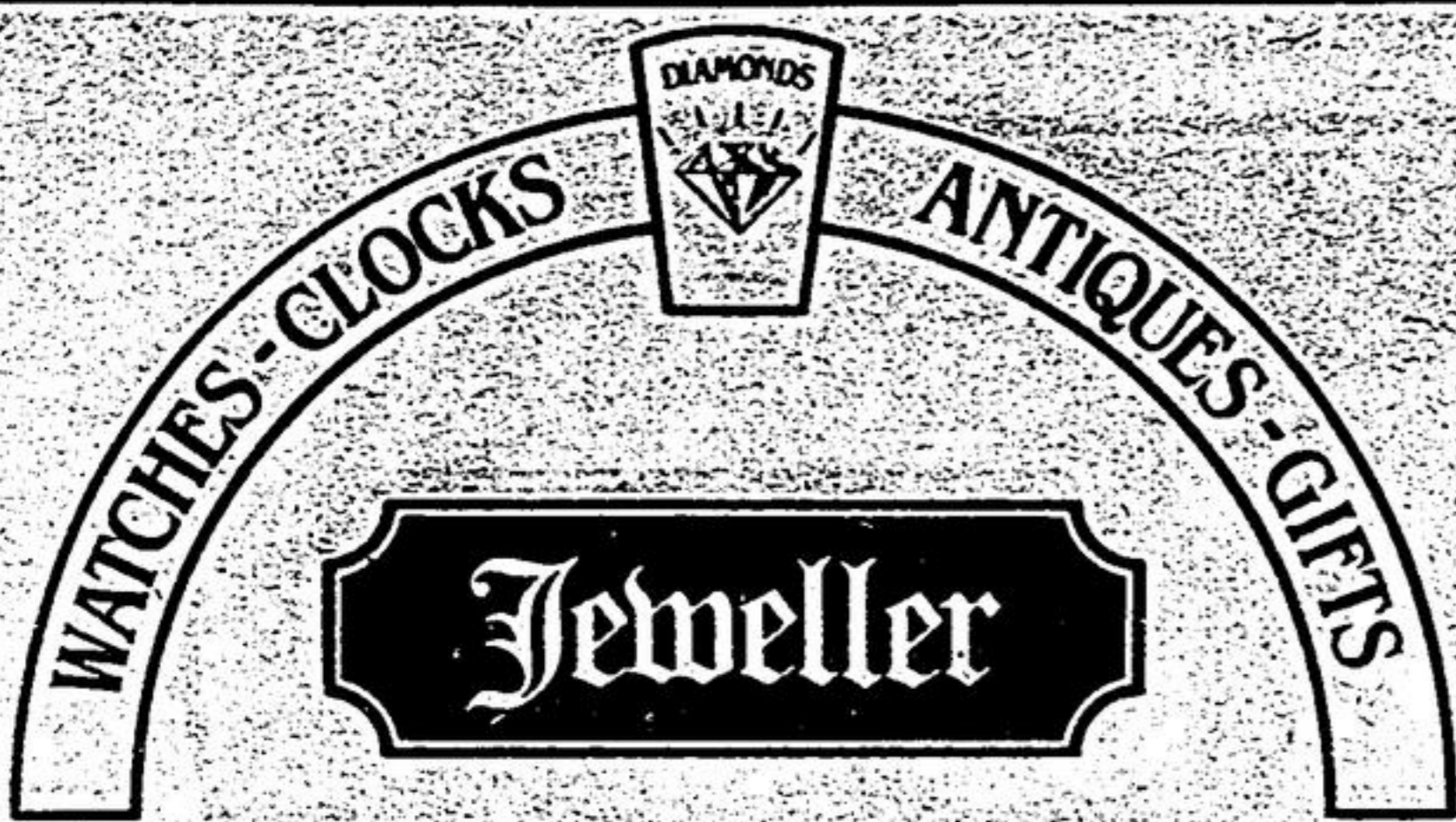
Local friends mourn passing
