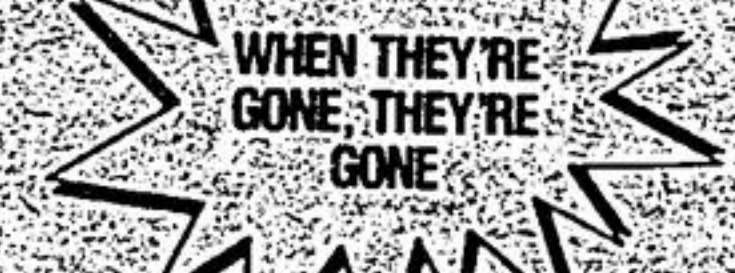

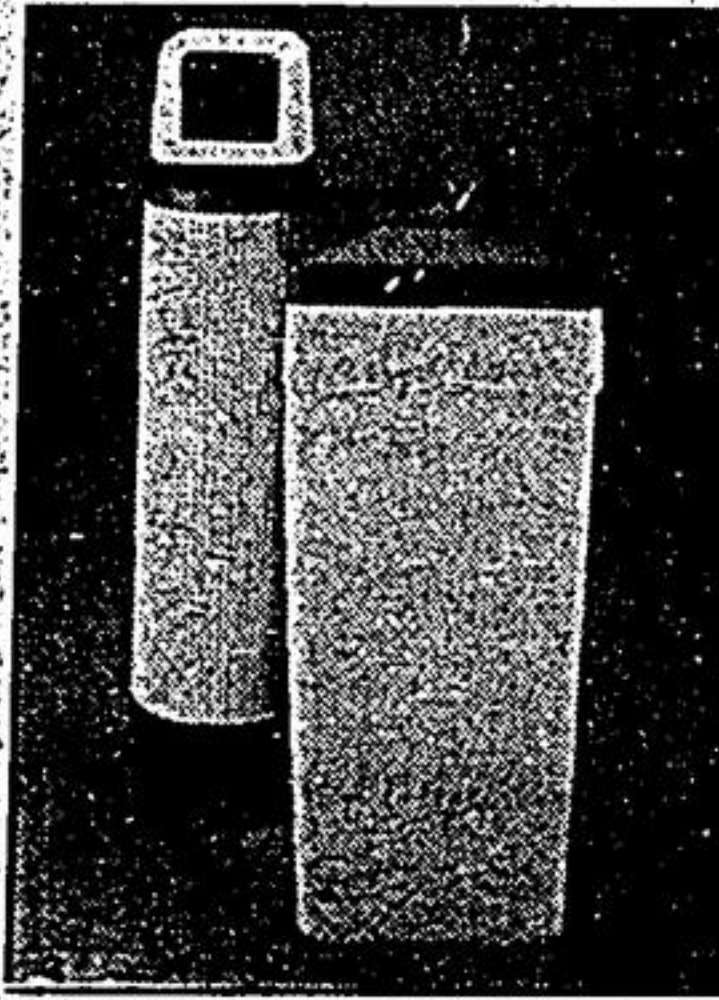

\$223,000 for local road improvement

Funds for a connecting link for Main Street at Stouffer Street and Market/Mill Streets in Stouffville was announced this week by York-Durham MPP Bill Ballinger.

The \$223,000 provincial windfall will also be used for intersection improvements and the installation of traffic lights, according to a release.

Mr. Ballinger made the announcement Monday on behalf of provincial Transportation Minister Bill Wrye.

"Commerce, tourism, agriculture and the general movement of people and goods in Whitchurch-Stouffville depend heavily on a well-maintained network of local roads, connecting with the provincial system," he said in the release.

"The government of Ontario is committed to the development of this network as a generator of economic growth and as a vital link for emergency services and social activities."
