Pleasure Valley, located on Brock Road north of Claremont, also welcomes Nordic skiers weekdays and weekends from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.

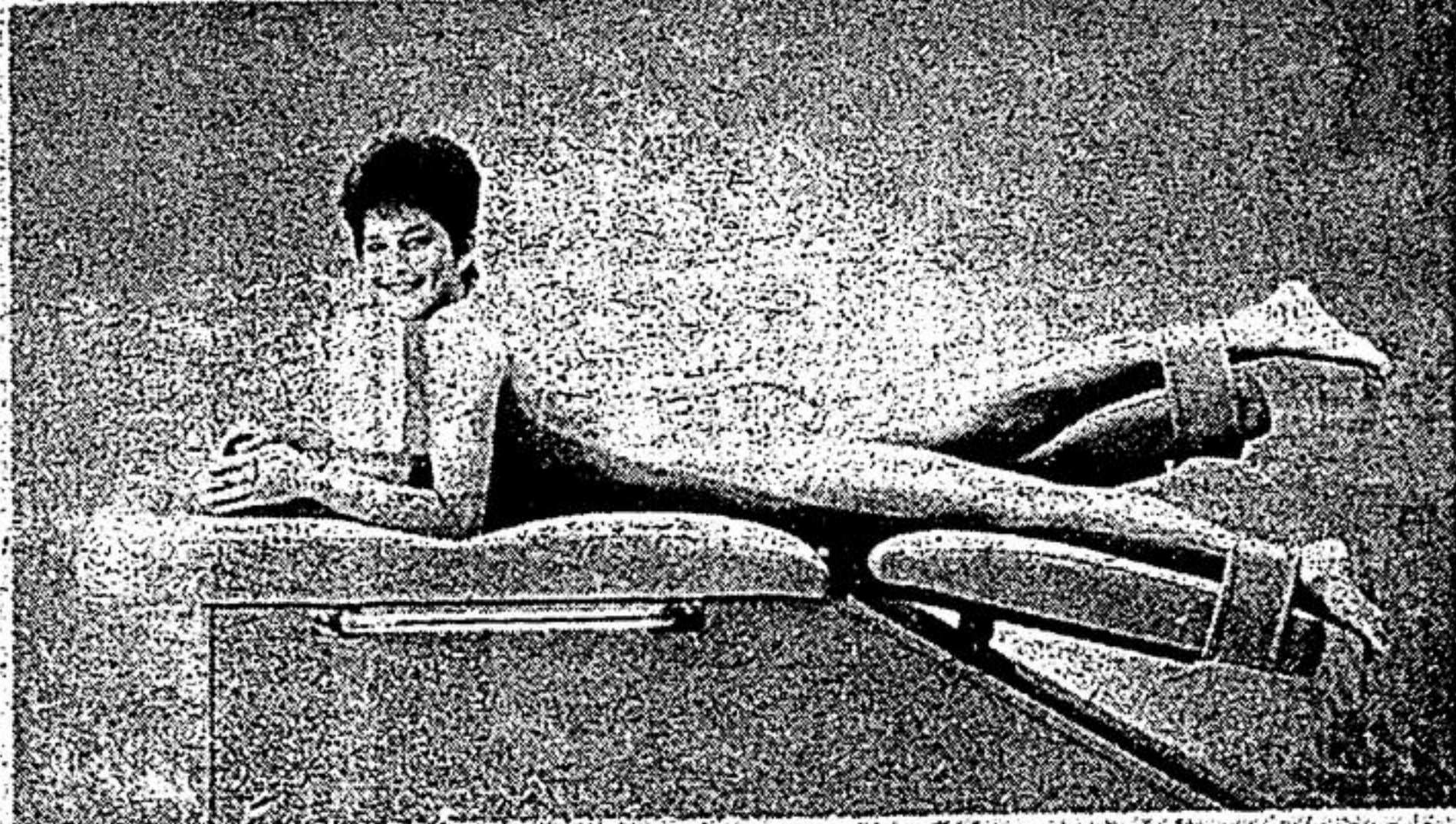
The resort features a total of 25 kilometres of groomed, double-tracked trails, including a self-instructional run.

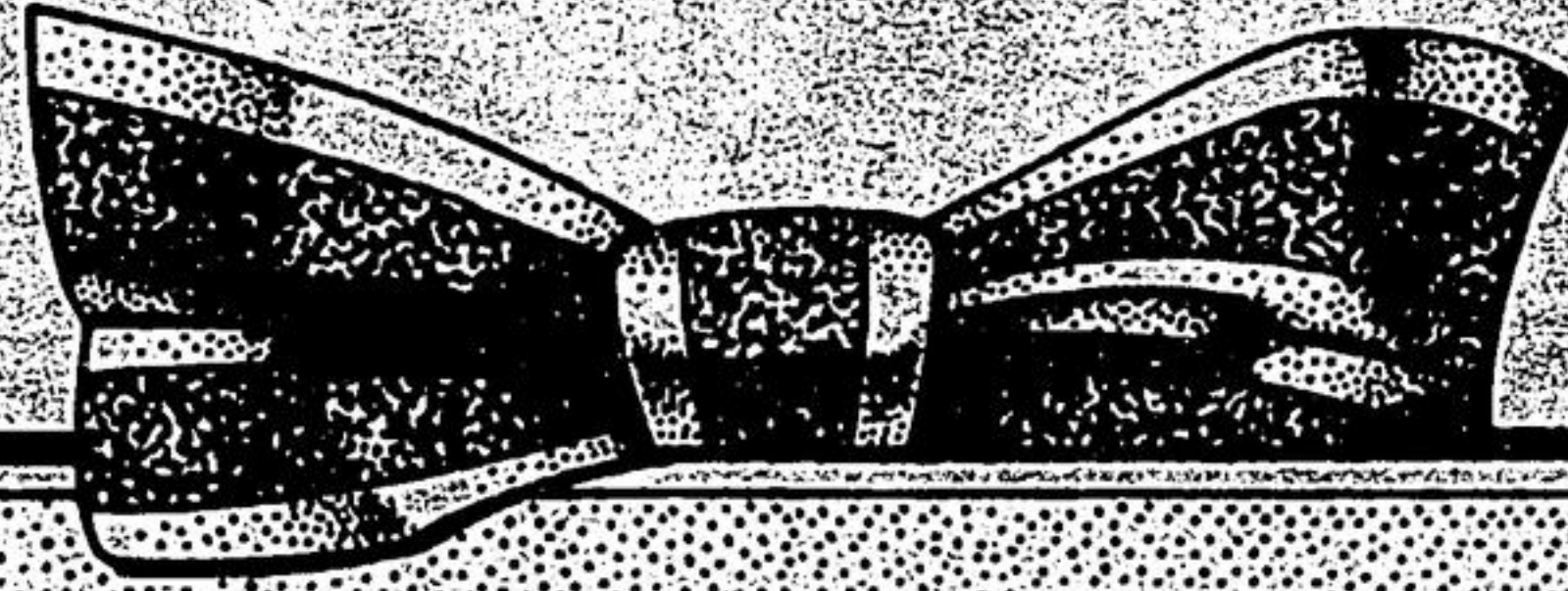
