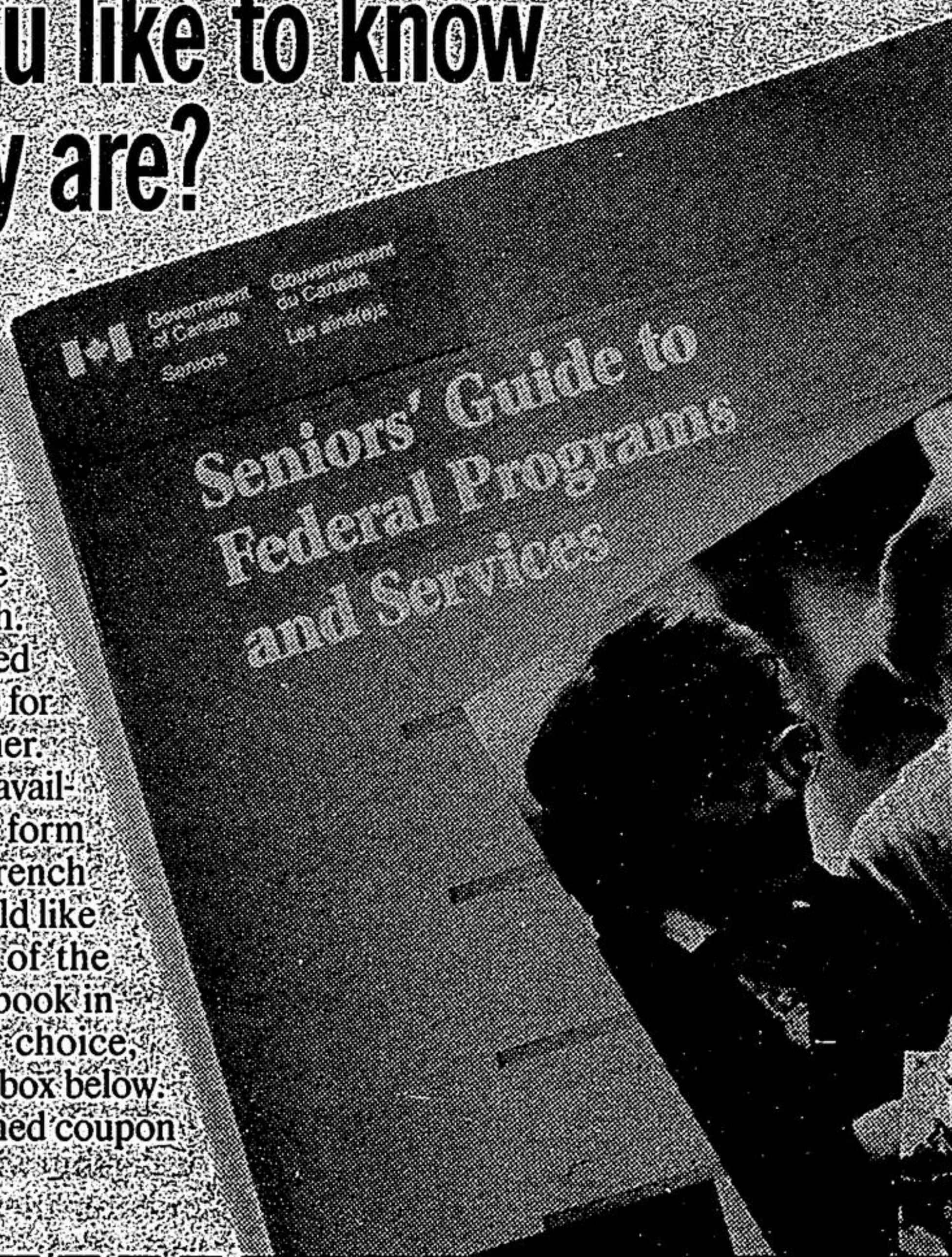
Helping hand

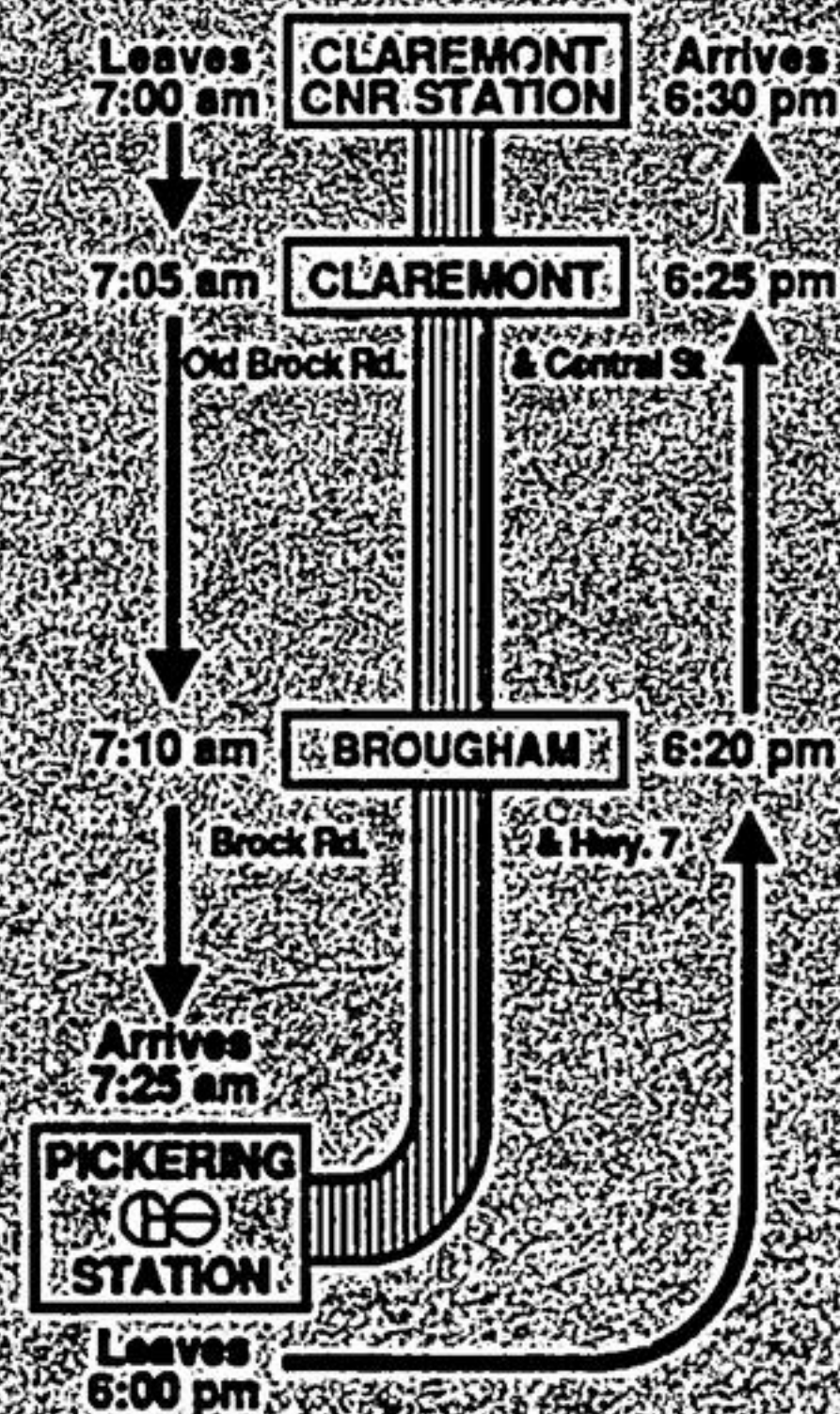
