Trees company in town

The Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville cannot prevent someone from cutting down trees and woods on private property, Council was told recently. Town Director of Planning Michael Saunders told councillors a letter from the Ministry of Natural Resources (MNR) informs the Town that only the Region can make a bylaw to prevent cutting down trees and wooded areas. "There is no legislation for municipalities to prevent the cutting down of woods and woodlots and trees," the letter states and the MNR advises the Town that it would need regional support to pass such a law. The letter cited examples in Muskoka and Haliburton where such a tree-cutting bylaw exists which can prevent people who own land from cutting down precious mature trees, considered a valuable part of the community's natural habitat. "I find it hard to swallow that if someone spends \$500,000 on property that someone can tell him he can't cut a tree down," said Ward 3 Councillor Nick Tatone.

But Mr. Saunders told Council the issue was not for individual trees but for whole wooded areas considered crucial to the environmental well-being of the community.

Some councillors said they are aware of people's concerns for areas on Warden Avenue, south of Hwy. 7 and near Hwy. 404 where woods have been cut down and at the southwest corner of 16th Avenue and Warden.

Mayor Fran Sainsbury fears the bylaw could "take away people's rights on private lands."

The mayor said York Region's solicitor is now reviewing such a bylaw and Council voted to wait and see what the recommendations are from the regional level.
