Mervyn Watts will be missed

A long-time, respected and active Stouffville citizen has died.

Mervyn Watts was 94 when he passed away suddenly two weeks ago at Markham Stouffville Hospital of acute leukemia.

Mr. Watts was born in Lemonville in 1895 and remained a dedicated Stouffville citizen until his death.

A veteran of the Royal Air Force in WWI, Mr. Watts returned home and spearheaded the organization of a Cadet Corp in Stouffville.

51 years

He dedicated 51 years as manager of Stiver Brothers (now Stouffville Feeds), served on village Council from 1930-36 and was Lions Club President in 1940, where he remained a valued chartered member earned from years of dedicated service.

When out of Lion chambers, Mr. Watts dedicated his time to the Kiwanis Club in Oshawa during the 70s.

Mr. Watts is survived by many nieces and nephews who faithfully threw birthday parties in his honor every July 1.

He lived with his nephew and his wife, Mr. and Mrs. Hamm of the 9th Line South for one year, and resided at the Buckingham Manor.

He is predeceased by his wife, Mabel and brother Irwin of Aurora.
