kidney pie, prime rib of beef with horseradish, roast stuffed leg of lamb, grilled swordfish steak with garlic butter and baked pork tenderloin.

Choice of dessert and tea or coffee round off a beautiful meal.

The four course meal offers a special soup, followed by a choice of salads, smoked salmon, honey

garlic shrimp, or escargot with garlic butter.

Entrees and desserts are the same as those on the three course menu.

Lunch is \$12.95 a head; dinner is \$26.95 for three courses and \$29.95 for four.

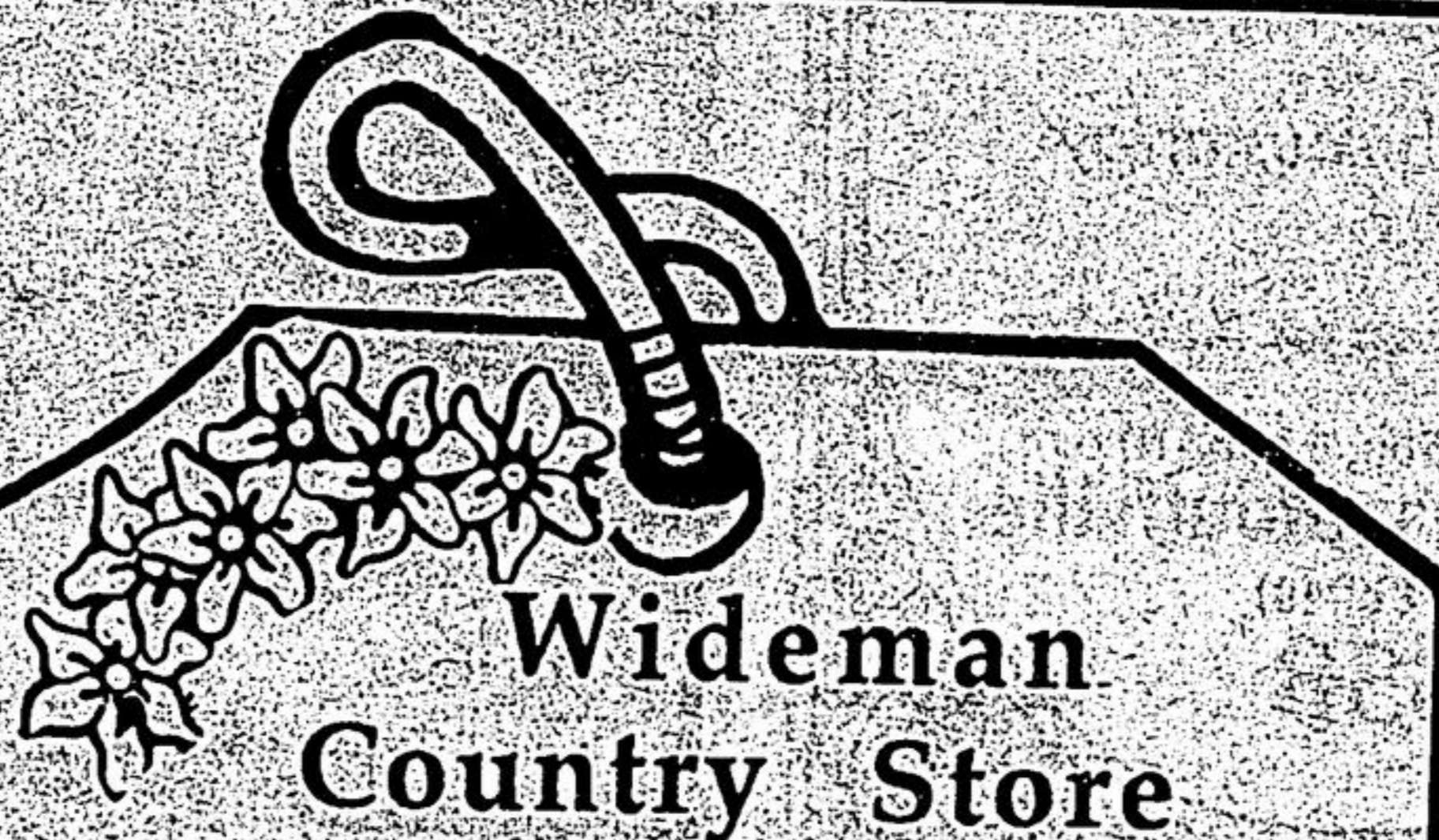
