Car rally success

Fundraiser benefits MS

The fight against Multiple Sclerosis was the big winner, recently at the Markham Fairgrounds.

The MS Trivia Car Rally and the Bouwmeister Bash Against MS netted more than \$40,000 - more than double the amount raised last year.

Nearly 130 cars, up more than 20 over last year, and 400 participants entered the rally, which covered a 72-kilometre course.

The Bouwmeister Bash attracted

more than 1,200 and they enjoyed an evening of rock 'n' roll featuring the band Hard Rein.

This year, rally participants broke all records in raising pledges. The top money collector was Fred Kendall of Markham, who obtained pledges of \$1,430.

He won a gas barbecue. Top pledges from an MS Society member was Jeannie Hardy of Stouffville, who collected \$1,106 and won a hotel weekend for two.

The rally was won by John and Sandy Torrington of Markham, who teamed up with Jim and Evie Groves of Gormley.

The foursome also won the event last year, and again share the grand prize - a trip for two to Las Vegas, with spending money.

Second place went to Jim Trantor and Scott Buncombe, both of Whitby, who won a 21" color television.

The rally and subsequent dance were strongly supported by many local businesses and numerous volunteers.

All proceeds are being used to fund client services in Stouffville, Markham and Unionville and to fund ongoing research to identify the causes and a cure for Multiple Sclerosis.

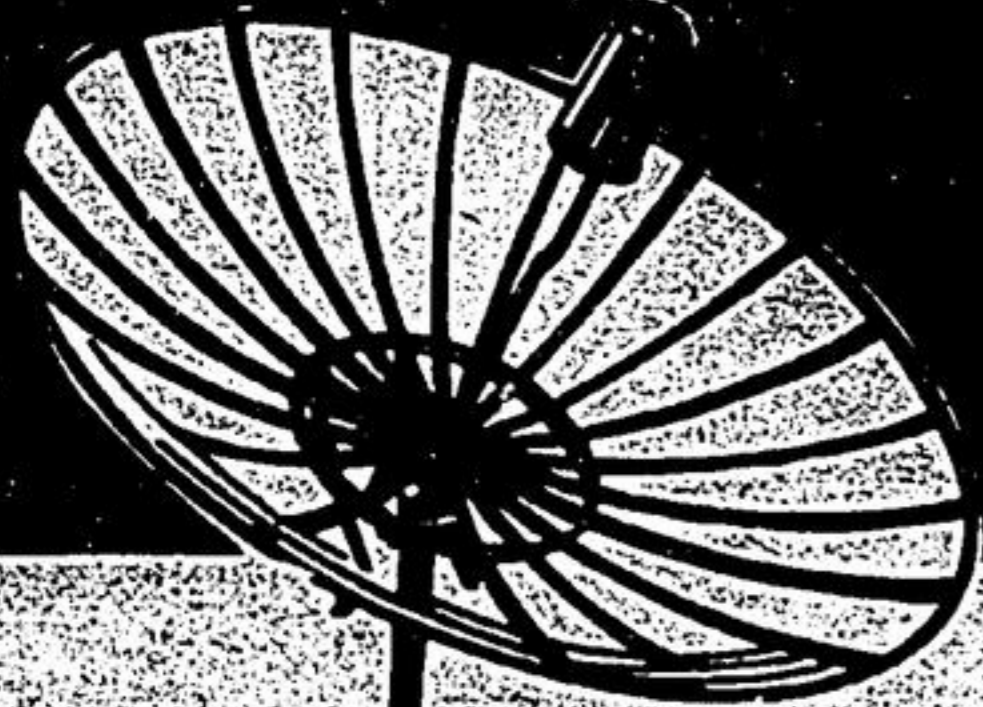
