

# Townend hot at SkyDome

Todd Townend made his SkyDome debut Friday night, making a strong showing in the Molson Export Supercross.

The local motocross racer captured his 250cc class semi-qualifier, but slipped to 18th position in the main event when an injury he

suffered early in the race left him with no strength in one hand.

Townend, in only his third ever Supercross event, had fractured a hip in competition the previous week.

He placed fifth in his first race Friday, but led all the way in his next qualifying heat.

A tie up at the start of the final resulted in the race being started again. Townend twisted his right elbow in the false start, and although he was among the top 10 for the first half of the championship event, he dropped back in the second half when he wasn't

able to draw his usual strength from his right hand.

Townend had been forced to compete with his practice bike, a 250 Suzuki, when his race bike had experienced problems after some pre-race modifications.

He said he was still trying to adjust to racing in an enclosed setting.

"I'm better outdoors than indoors," he conceded. "I think with a little more experience I'll get better indoors, though. I was a little disappointed with my results Friday, but I didn't do badly with what I had to work with."
