

Merchants earn pair of wins

The Stouffville Merchants Junior fastball team are making it easy to forget about the now defunct Betz Pools men's squad.

The younger Merchants, who have taken Betz's place in the Oshawa and District Men's Fastball League this year, racked up another two wins last week, bringing their record to five wins, one tie and a loss for the campaign to date.

The Stouffville club got an eight-strikeout shutout performance from Byron Baranieski in a 1-0 victory over the Oshawa Juniors last Tuesday on the road. The Merchants had nipped Oshawa 2-1 the week before.

This time, it was Scott Evans driving home Craig Crawford, who had singled and stolen second, in the fourth inning for the game's only run.

Wednesday, Rob Parcels drove in a pair of runs, and scored one himself, to lead the Merchants to a 5-3 win

over Sammy's of Richmond Hill in a cross-league contest at Stouffville Memorial Park.

Jamie Showers, Rich Burkholder, and Jason Yoshida all had an RBI and a run scored to round out the Stouffville attack. Evans pitched the first five frames, fanning four, while Baranieski came on for the final two innings, striking out three.

Stouffville suffered a serious blow Wednesday when Craig Crawford and Mike Clauson collided while chasing a ball in a York Region high school playoff game between their Markham District High School team and Stouffville District Secondary School.

According to Merchants' spokesperson Mary Myers, Crawford broke two bones in his leg, while Clauson suffered a fractured knee cap which will see him in a cast for a month.
