

# Pointers to prevent cottage crime

Hundreds of cottages are broken into every year. You can help protect your property by taking a few precautionary steps.

When you leave your cottage, take valuable portable items, firearms and liquor with you.

Valuable items which must be left at the cottage should be kept out of sight, and not visible through a window.

When you leave your boat unattended, remove all portable items, including small motors, whenever possi-

ble. Secure the boat with a good quality chain and padlock.

Make sure your cottage is adequately secured. Lock the doors, windows and any out-buildings. This reduces crimes of opportunity.

Install a loud burglar alarm system.

Mount the bell or siren high on the exterior of the cottage. If activated, other cottagers may hear the noise and advise the police.

If you find a door or window has been forced or broken while you were absent, do not enter - or call out...imme-

diately call the police.

Do not touch or move anything. Wait until the police arrive.

Know your neighbors. Form cottage associations. Keep watch on each other's property.

Know the exact location of your cottage and the police force responsible for that area.

This will save time if you need police assistance. Fill out the cottage identification sticker. Place it in a location visible from outside the cottage.

Identify your property - Operation Identification.

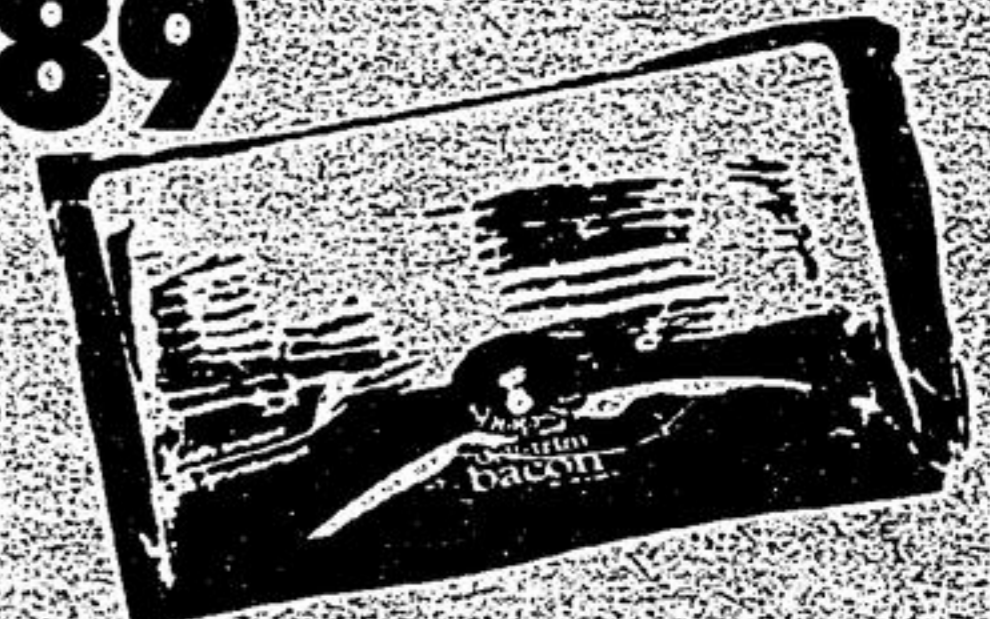
