1st Instalment due - August 24th, 1990
2nd Instalment due - October 19th, 1990

FINAL Tax bills have now been mailed. Rate payers who have not received their bills should make immediate application to the Municipal Tax Department. The PENALTY charged for non payment of 1990 taxes is one and one-quarter (1 1/4) percent imposed on the first day of default and on the first day of each month thereafter.

Failure to receive a tax bill does not eliminate the responsibility for payment of taxes nor the penalty charge for late payment.
