TAKE NOTICE THAT The Corporation of the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville intends to pass a by-law to annually close and stop up the walkways shown as Block 16 on Plan 65M-2651, Block 22 on Plan 65M-2763, Block 35 on Plan 65M-2337, Block 42 on Plan 65M-2578, Blocks I and J on Plan M-41, and the walkway between Lots 2 and on Plan 65M-2048, Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville during the period between October 31 and April 1.

AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE THAT the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville shall, at the hour of 8:00 p.m. Tuesday, August 14th, 1990, in the Council Chambers of the Municipal Buildings at 19 Civic Avenue, Stouffville, Ontario, hear any person who claims that he/she will be adversely affected by the by-law and applies to be heard.

His brow cleared. "That's it, then," he said, with the air of Sherlock Holmes brilliantly identifying an unlikely murderer.

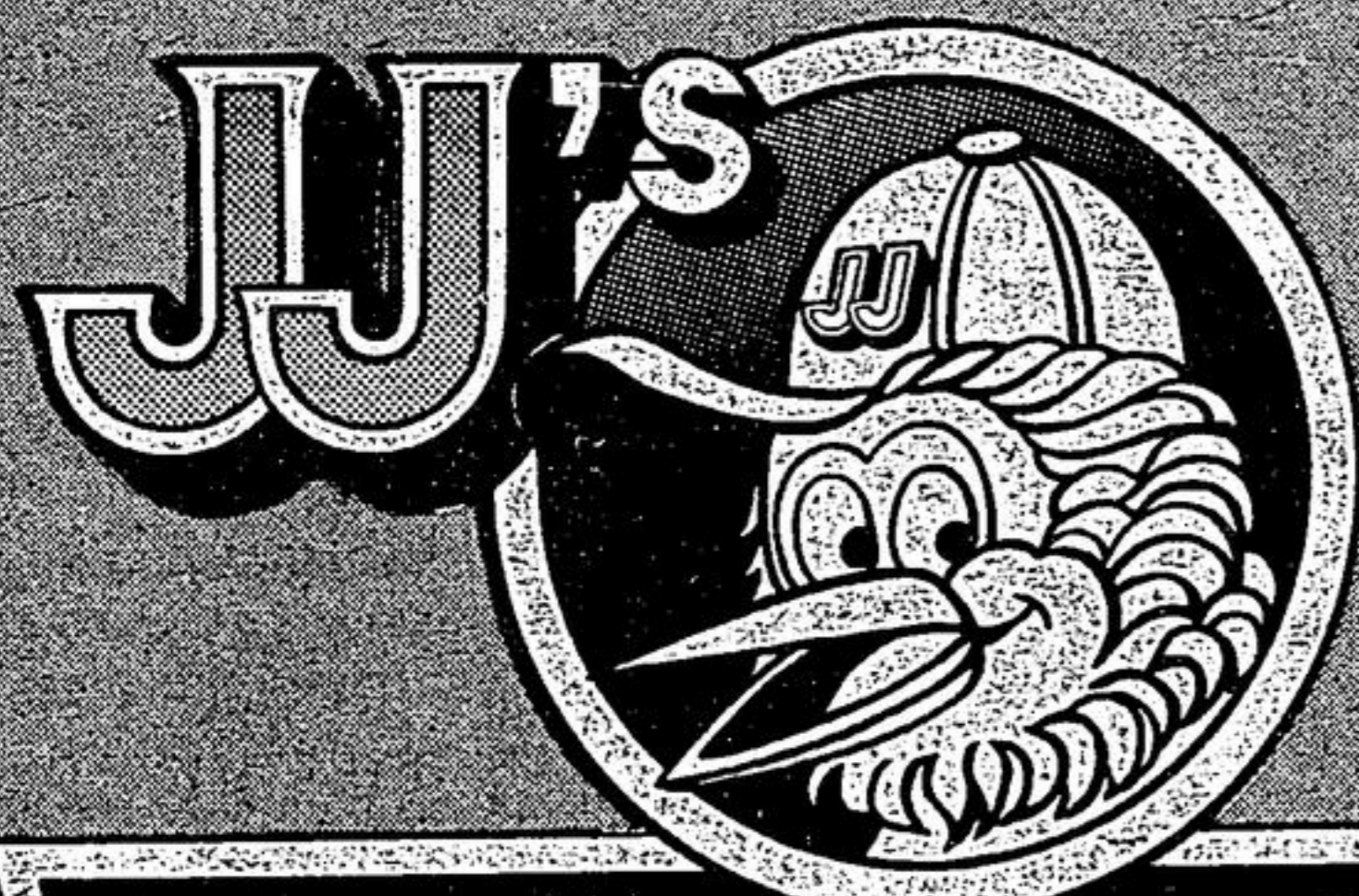
"She's jealous. I was prepared for a physically sick cat, but one with emotional problems?"

NOTICE TO ALL PROPERTY AND BUSINESS OWNERS IN THE TOWN OF WHITCHURCH-STOUFFVILLE

NEW MUNICIPAL ADDRESS SYSTEM

In preparation for the new 911 Emergency Response Plan, the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville has undertaken the task of assigning new numbers for all properties on major Town roads.

The majority of the properties affected currently do not have assigned numbers, however some renumbering will be required on certain streets, namely Stouffville Road / Main Street, the Ninth Line and the 10th Concession which are presently numbered.

Note: The proposed renumbering scheme does not affect properties in existing residential or industrial subdivisions.

The main purpose of the new municipal address system is to provide a uniform numbering scheme throughout the Town. This uniformity is a major component to the 911 Emergency Response Plan. The numbering scheme will assist in identifying and locating properties by the emergency service (Police, Fire Department and Ambulance Services) for a quicker response.

Another benefit of the uniform numbering scheme will be the easier identification of your property by customer service related businesses (i.e. heating oil deliveries, hydro, telephone, etc.)

The proper posting of your new number will also eliminate confusing directions to your property.

e.g. - 65 Main Street (east or west?)
Kennedy Road, north of Bloomington, the second laneway past the green barn on the west side.

In order to display your new number most effectively, standardized reflective signs will be made available to residents of the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville affected by this change, at a cost of \$10.00 per sign.

These signs may be picked up in person only at Stouffville District One Fire Station (old address) - 65 Main Street East, Stouffville, (new address) - 6392 Main Street during the months of August and September between the following times:

Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
Thursday and Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
Saturday and Sunday, 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

The implementation and success of this program is dependent on your support and co-operation. The benefits in emergency and support service response will far outweigh the temporary inconvenience this will cause.

Pursuant to By-Law Number 90-103, as amended, all new numbers shall be posted by November 30, 1990.
