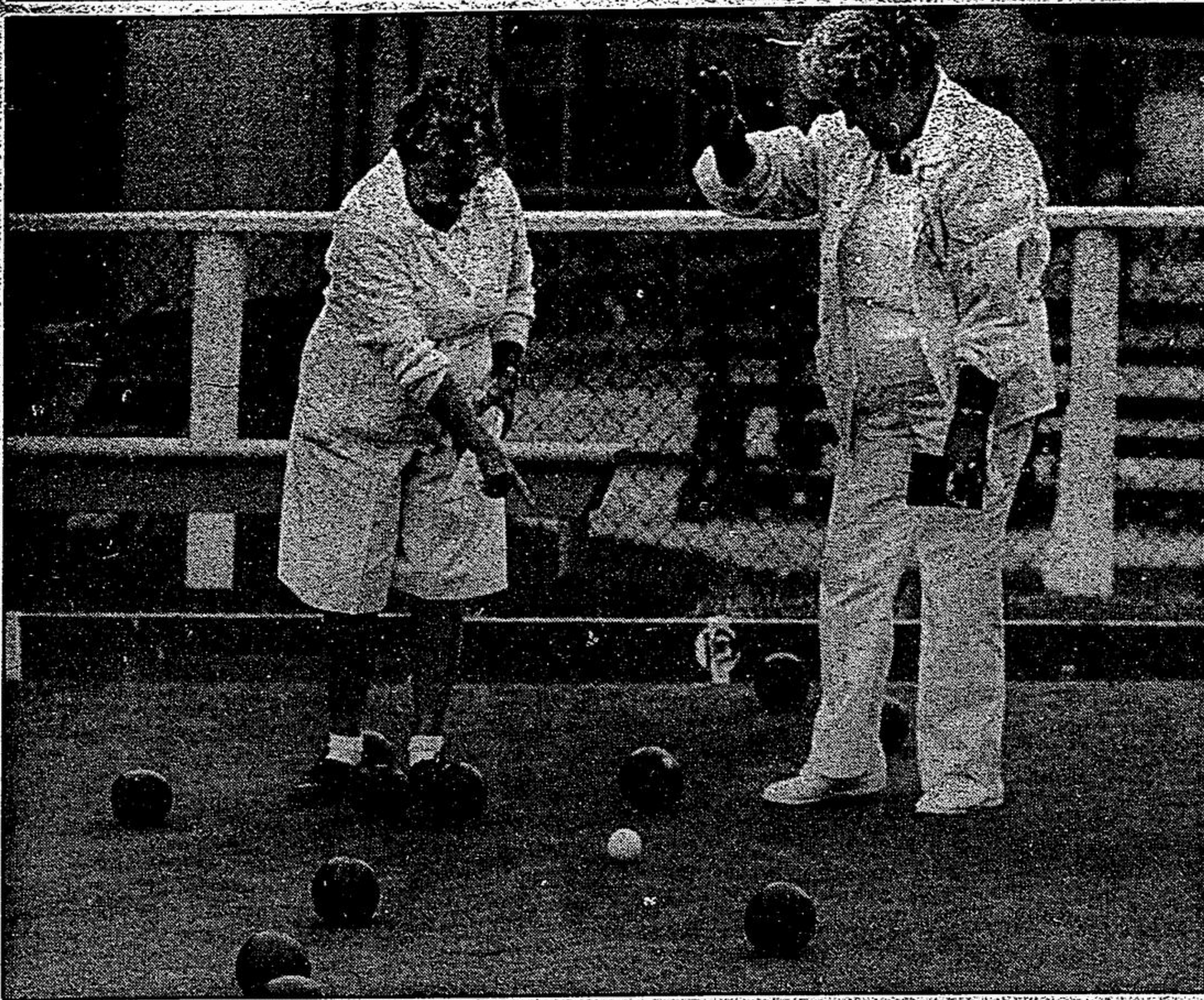


Bowling action at Crossen tourney

INVITATION TO COMMENT DRAFT RURAL AREA POLICY INCLUDING LOCATIONAL CRITERIA FOR GOLF COURSES

At the request of Pickering Town Council, Planning staff has prepared Planning Report No. 7/90 addressing locational criteria for golf courses.

During the review, staff concluded that golf course policies should be developed in the context of an overall rural area policy. Thus, the draft policy includes general rural area policies plus specific golf course policies.

On June 25, 1990, Town Council received Planning Report No. 7/90 and requested that it be circulated to the community for comment and further input.

Pickering residents, landowners and other interested individuals are invited to submit comments on the draft policy to the Town Planning Department. Copies of Planning Report No. 7/90 are available to be picked up from the Planning Department, Pickering Civic Complex, One the Esplanade, or you may request that a copy be mailed to you by calling the Town Planning Department at 420-4617 or 683-2760.
