**PUBLIC NOTICE**  
BALLANTRAE AND MUSSelman LAKE  
WATER WORKS PROJECT

The Regional Municipality of York and the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville are planning the above mentioned project pursuant to the Environmental Assessment Act. Under the Act, the project is subject to a Class Environmental Assessment for Municipal Water Supplies.

A number of studies and public meetings have been undertaken since 1986 to define the need for a new water system, to evaluate alternatives and received public input for the project. This process culminated in the publication of an Environmental Study Report (ESR) which summarizes the previous phases of the work and describes the proposed undertaking in detail. The ESR has been on public display at the Town offices since November 15, 1989.

As a result of the public review of this document, a number of parties expressed concerns that some environmental issues had not been adequately addressed. Several requests were received to bump-up the project to a full environmental assessment.

The Environmental Assessment process for municipal water supplies allows two options at this stage. The first option is to submit the ESR document and the concerns expressed by the public to a review by the Minister of the Environment who would decide whether or not the project warrants a full environmental assessment. The second option is to defer this Ministerial review until the proponents (in this case the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville and the Region of York) have the opportunity to satisfy the outstanding concerns through meetings with the concerned parties, conducting additional studies and the issuance of an Addendum to the ESR, detailing how the various concerns will be met. The proponents have elected the second option.

The Addendum to the Environmental Study Report (ESR), prepared for this project and filed with the Town Clerk, will be available for public review for a period of five (5) days commencing July 23, 1990 in accordance with the Class Environmental Process.

If the Addendum satisfies the concerns previously expressed, the bump-up requests may be withdrawn. If the previous bump-up requests are withdrawn and no new requests are received, the project will proceed. If serious environmental concerns remain unresolved, new requests may be made to the Minister of the Environment that the project be subject to a full environmental assessment.

It is not necessary to renew bump-up requests that were formally withdrawn.

The final decision regarding requests for a full environmental assessment rests with the Minister of the Environment.

The Whitchurch-Stouffville Council and staff will be available to respond to questions and comments with respect to the proposed project.
