

Citizens sought for awards from conservation authority

The Lake Simcoe and Region Conservation Authority (LSRCA) is asking Whitchurch-Stouffville residents to help it select people in the community who are worthy of one of the many awards it offers every year.

The LSRCA is seeking nominations from groups or individuals for the 1990 Conservation Awards Program, marking its 10th year in presenting these awards.

Through this program the LSRCA attempts to increase an awareness of conservation within the community by honoring individuals, members of the media, community groups and companies who have made a significant contribution to the conservation of our renewable natural resources within the Lake Simcoe Region watershed," the LSRCA announced last week.

The authority is seeking nominations for these four

awards: The Conservation Award of Honor, recognizing an individual for outstanding accomplishments in conservation of renewable resources; The Conservation Award of Merit, recognizes outstanding conservation activities of community groups, service clubs, business or industry, public or private; The Water Conservation Award, recognizes individuals or organizations of the agricultural community for outstanding accomplishments in water conservation; The Soil Conservation Award, recognizes individuals or organizations of the agricultural community for outstanding accomplishments in soil conservation.

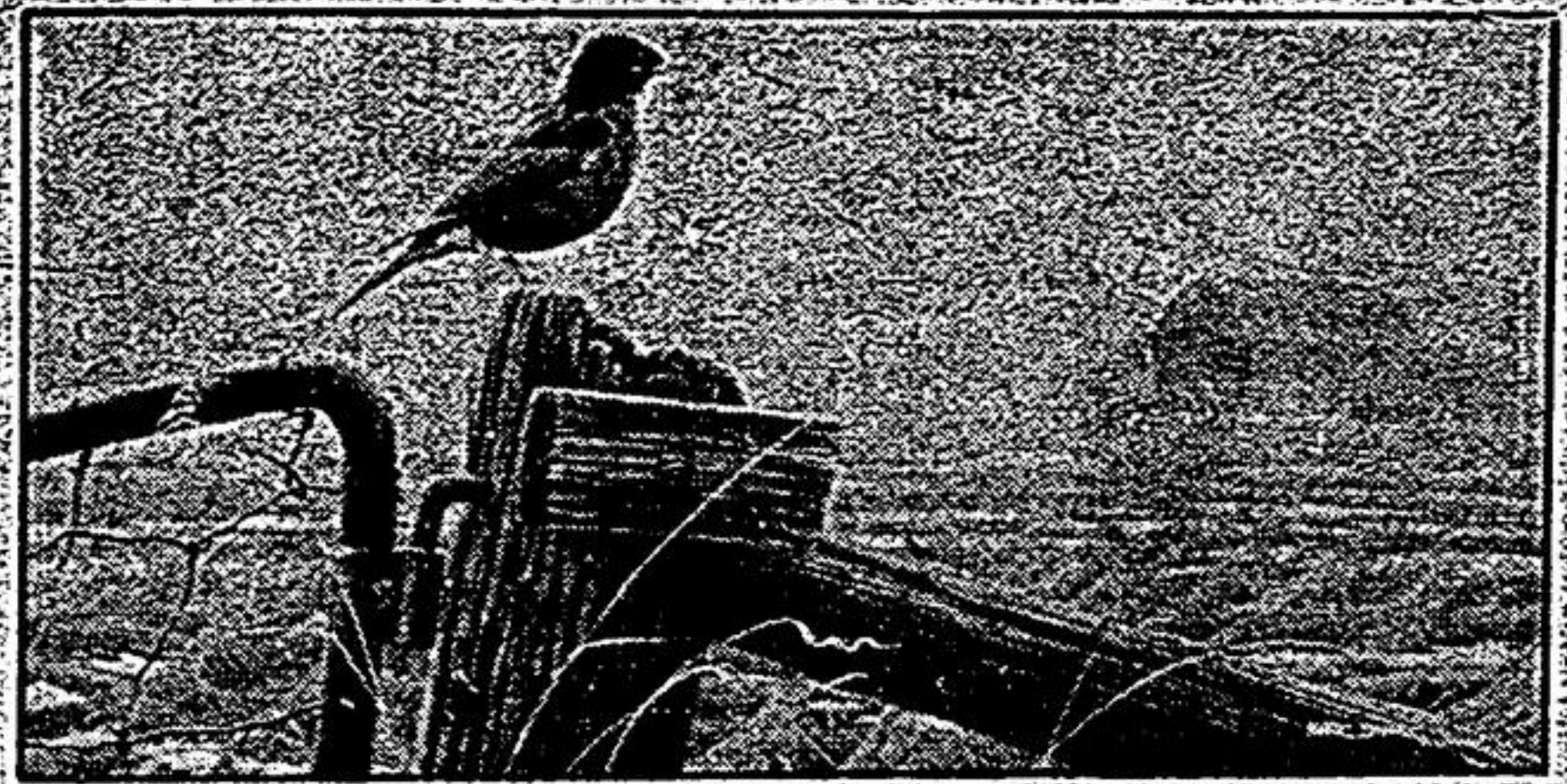

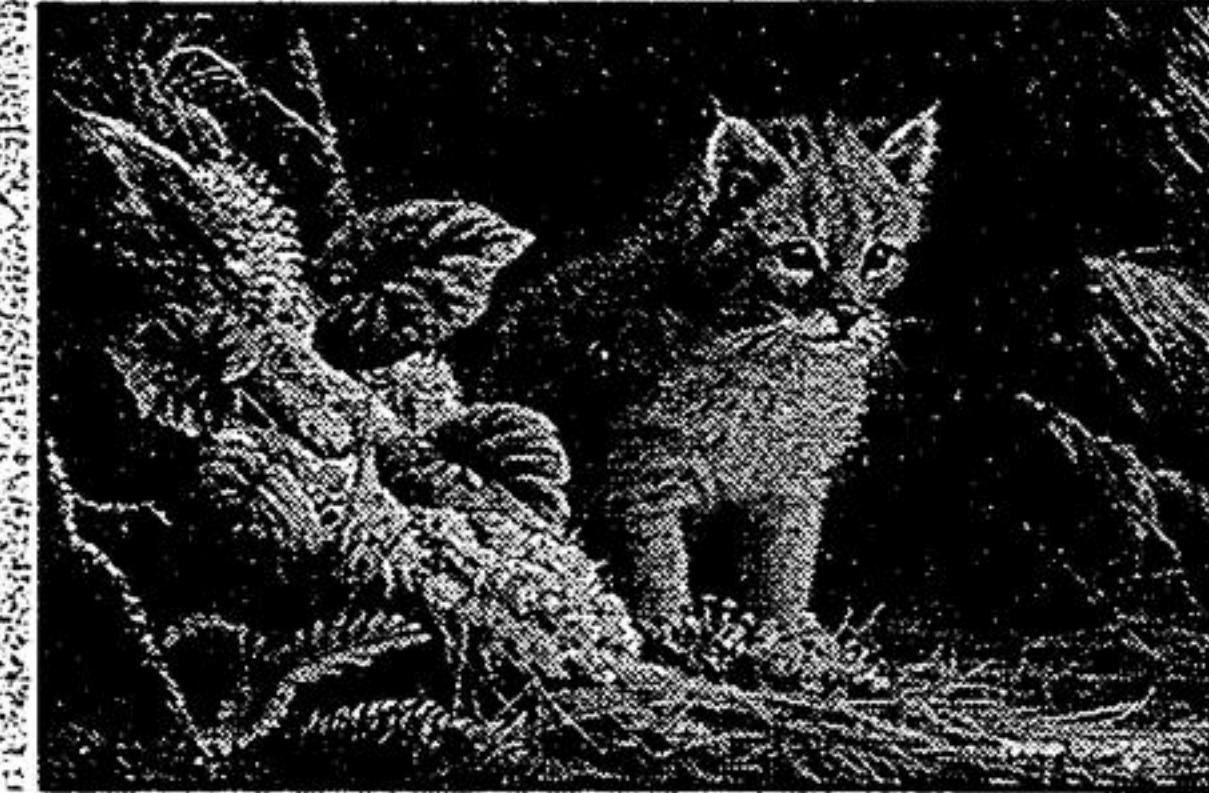
