Farm tax rebate plan starting

The Ontario Ministry of Agriculture and Food will provide \$151 million in farm tax rebates for the 1990-91 Farm Tax Rebate Program.

Owners of farm property in agricultural production will receive a rebate equal to 75 per cent of taxes levied on eligible farmland and outbuildings.

The Farm Tax Rebate Program, a two-year deal, reflects the principal that all owners of farm property in agricultural production should be treated equally.

The program's focus is on land in agricultural

production.

To be eligible for the first year's rebate, farm property must be used as a part of a farming operation with a gross production value of at least \$7,000 in 1990.

The announcement follows an evaluation of the program by a committee composed of representatives of the farming community and officials of the Ministry of Agriculture and Food.

Applications and brochures will be mailed to owners of farm property in mid-September of this year.

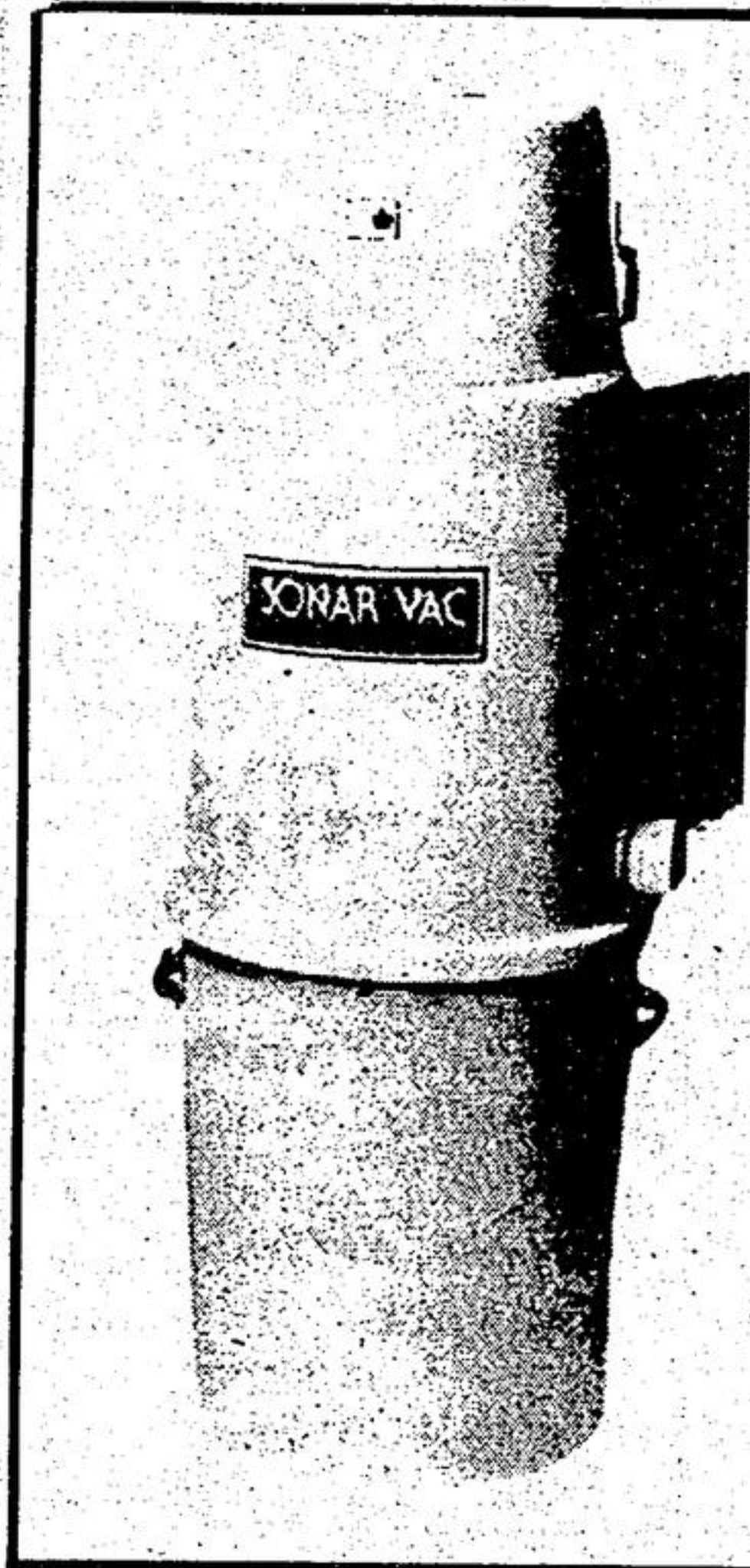

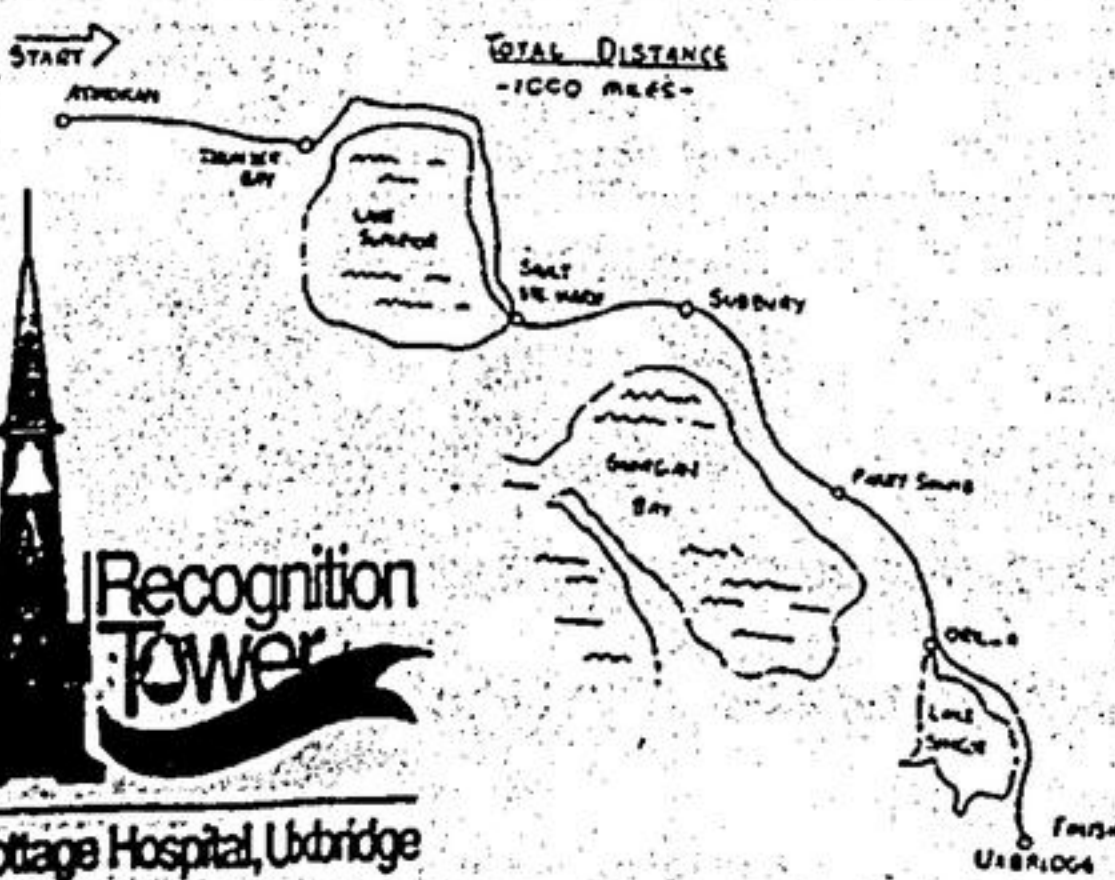
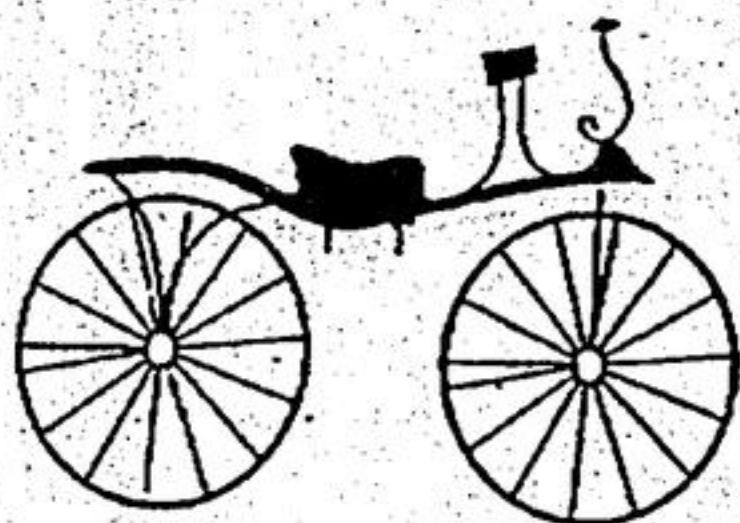
