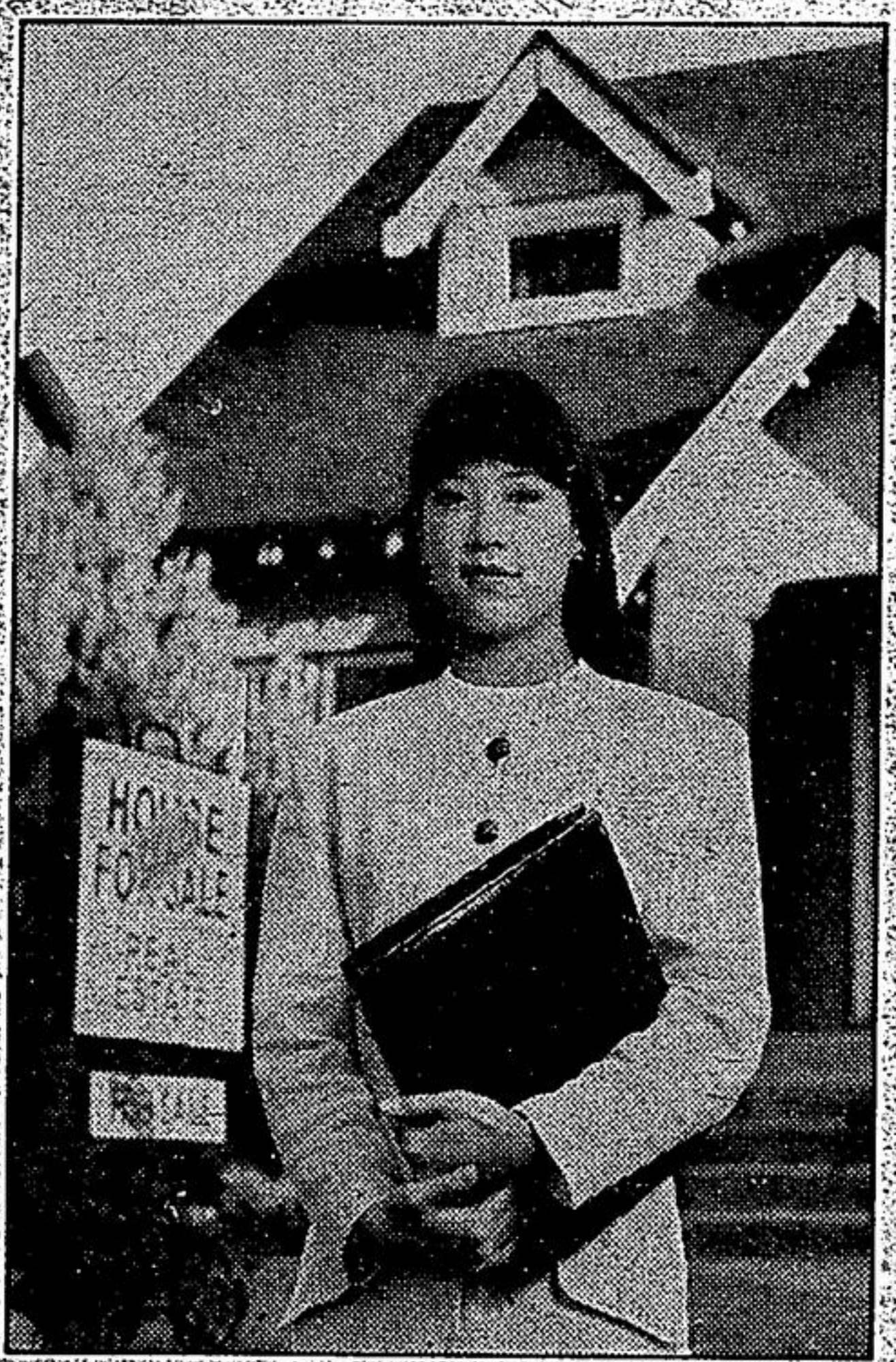
HOLIDAY ICE SCHEDULE
