

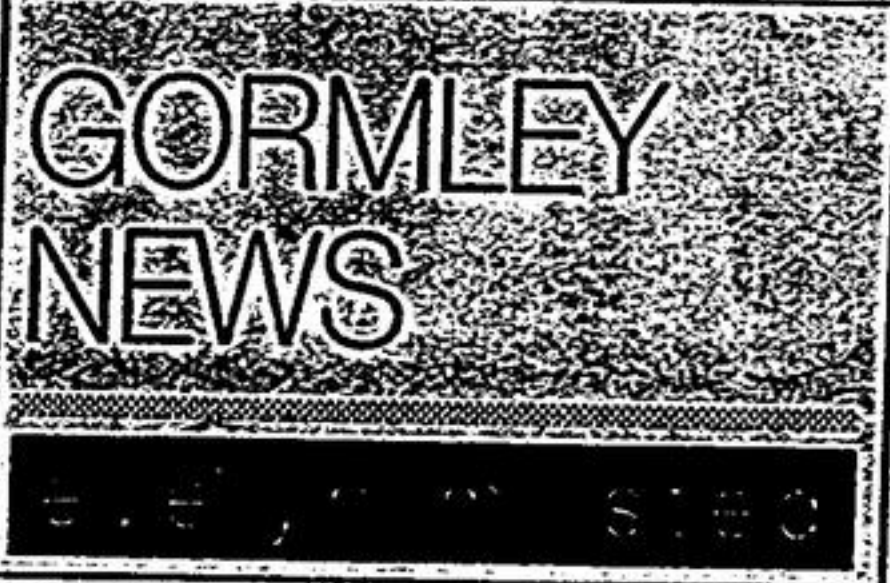
# Sympathy goes out to Ellas family
