Economic Development Advisory Committee

The Council of The Corporation of the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville has endorsed the creation of an Economic Development Advisory Committee.

Duties of the Committee

The Economic Development Advisory Committee shall be established:

- To provide the Town Council with appropriate industrial/commercial development advice on the strategy that should be considered/promoted by the Town.
- To function as a forum for discussion on the Town's potential industrial/commercial growth by bringing together representation of the Town, the Chamber of Commerce, the B.I.A., members of the Industrial community, the public and developers.
- To function as a forum for discussion on current issues, proposals, and plans that have been adopted by the Town.
- To act as a liaison group among the various development interest groups, real estate groups promoting industrial/commercial lands within the Town.
- To comment on significant applications for industrial/commercial development in the Town.
- To discuss with Council promotional and advertising initiatives.

Composition and Term

The Economic Development Advisory Committee shall be comprised as follows:

- The Committee shall be appointed by the Town Council and shall consist of 10 members namely; two (2) members of Council; two (2) members of the Chamber of Commerce; two (2) members of the B.I.A.; two (2) members of the public; one (1) member representing the local Real Estate Businesses; and the Chief Administrative Officer of the Town.
- Shall serve a term co-terminous with the legislated term of Council.
- The Members of the Public shall be qualified electors of the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville pursuant to the Municipal Elections Act.
- May not serve more than two (2) terms with the exception of Council and the C.A.O.
- Shall prepare an Annual Report for Council on the activities of the Committee.
- Shall select a Chairman and Vice-Chairman among the Members.

Anyone interested participating as a member of the Committee is encouraged to apply. Application forms may be picked up in person at the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville Civic Centre or by calling our office. We will gladly mail or fax you a copy.

Applications must be submitted no later than April 30, 1991.
