All interested parents and guardians are asked to attend.

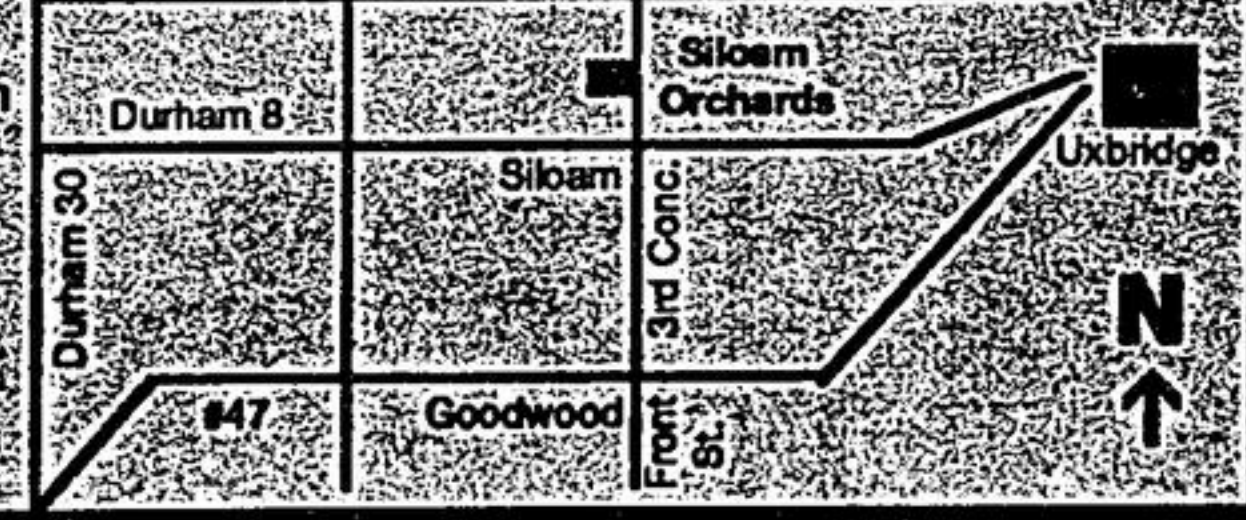
