

# Stouffville foodbank grateful for contributions made in August

 Last month, Whitchurch-Stouffville Foodbank (WSF) cried help to the community. The foodbank needed more food as donations were down. Well, we asked and we received! Once again, the people in Whitchurch-Stouffville showed us their generosity by giving food and money, and by volunteering their time. There are many people, organizations, churches, and businesses to thank. On behalf of the committee, I would like to thank all the families who donated to us. Many people gave produce from their bountiful gardens (WSF has one refrigerator and three freezers). It was a joy for the volunteers to receive the donations because so many people shared personal stories that touched us in very special ways. People wanted to share not just the food, but to give of themselves.  
 Thanks to A&P, Food Villa Bakery, John Vince, Reesor Farms, Parkview Village, Progress Club, Glenbrook Day Camp, all church donations, Care and Share Shop and the Stouffville Tribune. WSF received approximately \$900 in donations from Music Mania, IGA and concerned individuals. We appreciate these donations as every month we purchase food that we do not receive. Some people do not believe that one can of food per week from every

household is enough to support our needy, but last month, it proved true. In August, WSF was totally supported by our community. All the food collected came from within Whitchurch-Stouffville boundaries. WSF fed 47 families without using Daily Bread in Toronto.  
 Our statistics for August were:  
 Total number of households - 47  
 New households - 7  
 Children (under 20) - 97  
 Single parent families - 20  
 Two-parent families - 35  
 Senior couples - 6  
 Single people - 17  
 Total people - 211  
 Your donation does make a difference. It is a fact that 17,000 people can support a community foodbank, but we need your help. The only way that we can meet our monthly goal is to receive one can of food per household per week. We ask you to please think of the children (approximately 100-150) that we are feeding each month and that your donation is making this possible.  
 We are presently looking for a weekly contribution of 10 to 15 dozen eggs.

This will meet our weekly requirements with the amount of space that is available at Churchill Baptist Church. If anyone can help, please call the food-

bank at 640-4704. It would be an answer to our prayers.  
 By working together we can do it and the children will not go hungry. One
