

Some Catholic students may face change of schools

Catholic students living in York Region but attending school elsewhere will be drawn back into the local system if the separate board changes its tuition fee policy. The York Region Roman Catholic Separate School Board has no control over the current guidelines and

pays more than \$7.5 million for 1,400 students to attend other boards. A revision of the policy would draw most of the children back into the system except students requiring services not offered at the board. There is no control. This amount could double next year. It could

triple, business superintendent John Sabo said. A proposal for the board to educate its own external students was debated at last week's finance committee meeting, but a vote was postponed

until this month's meeting. The recommended option would involve paying for Grade 12 and OAC students to continue at their current schools until graduation while telling all other secondary stu-

dents that as of Sept. 1, 1992, payment of tuition fees will be severed. The same rule would apply to Grades 7 and 8 students who would be allowed to stay at their current school until the end of Grade 8.

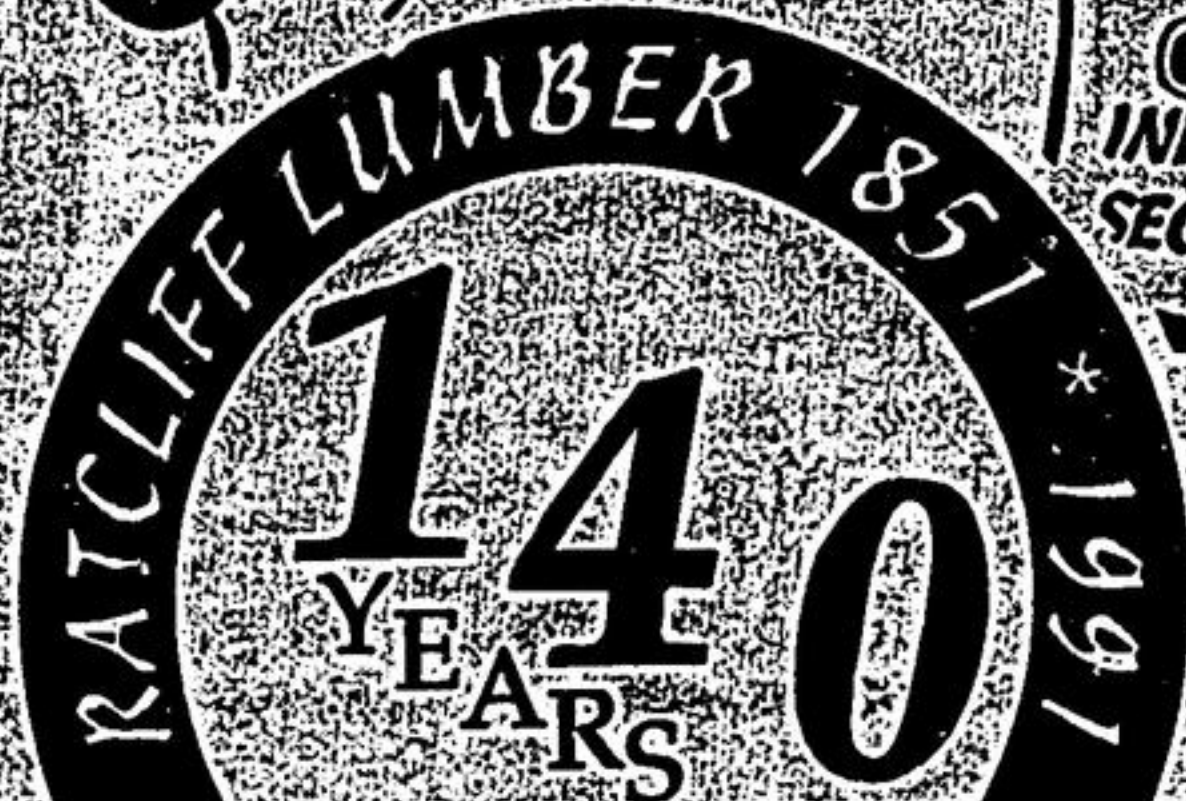
