

Stouffville students tackle tough words at area spelling bee

Twenty-four young scholars wrestled with some of the most formidable words in the English language Wednesday at the Area Spelling Bee at Bayview Elementary School in Richmond Hill.

When it was all over, only two remained, as the Area Junior and Intermediate candidates were

decided for the York Region Board of Education finals Nov. 28. Stouffville schools came out the big winners in the competition.

Orchard Park Public School's Naomi Ishiguro captured the Junior honors, with Marissa Stapley of Summitview Public School prevailing in the Intermediate divi-

sion. Monique Matthew, of Henderson Ave. P.S. in Thornhill took second position in the Junior contest. Anthony Collins of Thornhill's Bayview Fairways P.S. was third.

Sarah Kamin, who also attends Henderson, placed second in the Intermediate spell off.

Maxine Bond, of Stouffville's Dickson Hill P.S. won the third place medal.

The Intermediate contest was ended when both finalists misspelled the word sustenance.

Stapley was declared the winner because she had not erred previously in the double-knockout format.

The event included representatives from schools from the region's Areas D, E, F, and H, with 14 entrants competing at the Junior and 10 at the Intermediate levels.

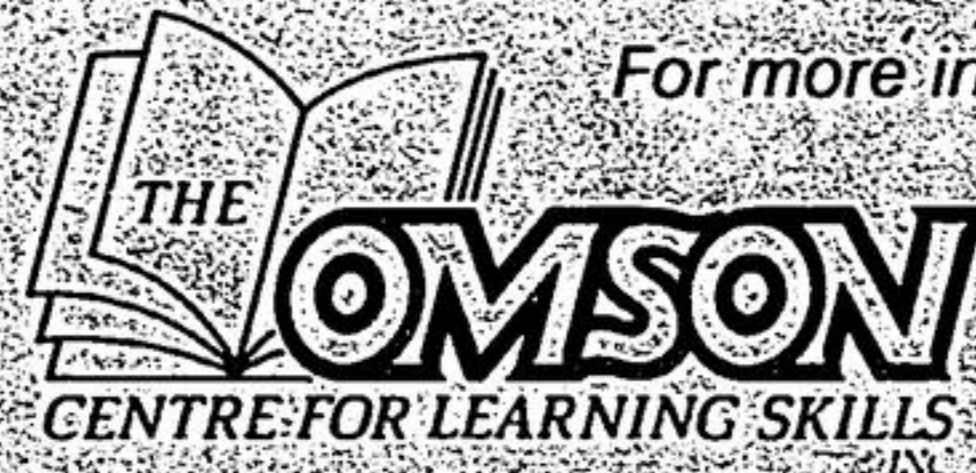

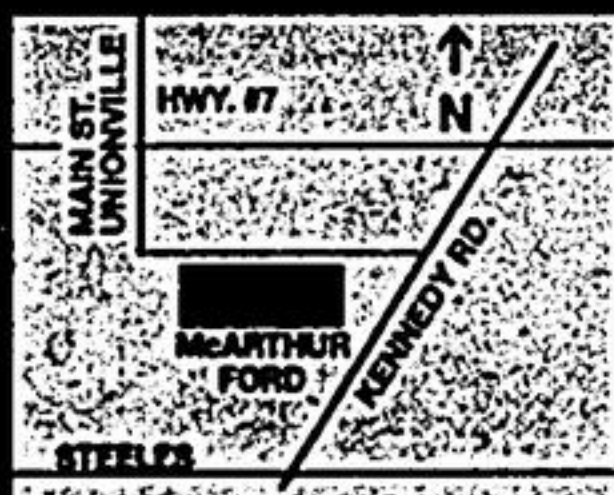
