

# Local members sought by York District Health Council

York Region's newly formed District Health Council is looking for individuals interested in

health-related issues to sit on its 20-member board.

York DHC recently kicked off a region-wide recruitment campaign in search of nominees whose

names will be considered for a short list of applicants and submitted to the province for final approval.

DHC program co-ordinator Jane Brown said board members will be chosen to represent consumers, health care providers and local government.

"Applicants should have an interest in health, wellness, live or work in York Region and be able to devote time and energy to monthly council meetings," said Brown.

"I think there will be a lot of

dynamite individuals out there looking to give their time to sit on the board," she said.

The board will be made up of 20 members, including chairman John Rogers, Brown said.

Of the 20 members, eight will be consumers, eight will be health care providers and three will be either elected officials or representatives of local government.

Brown said a short list of 40 applicants will be compiled from all the nominations and submitted to the Ministry of Health for final approval.

Brown stressed DHC members will not receive remuneration for sitting on the board.

## Reformers meet Feb. 3

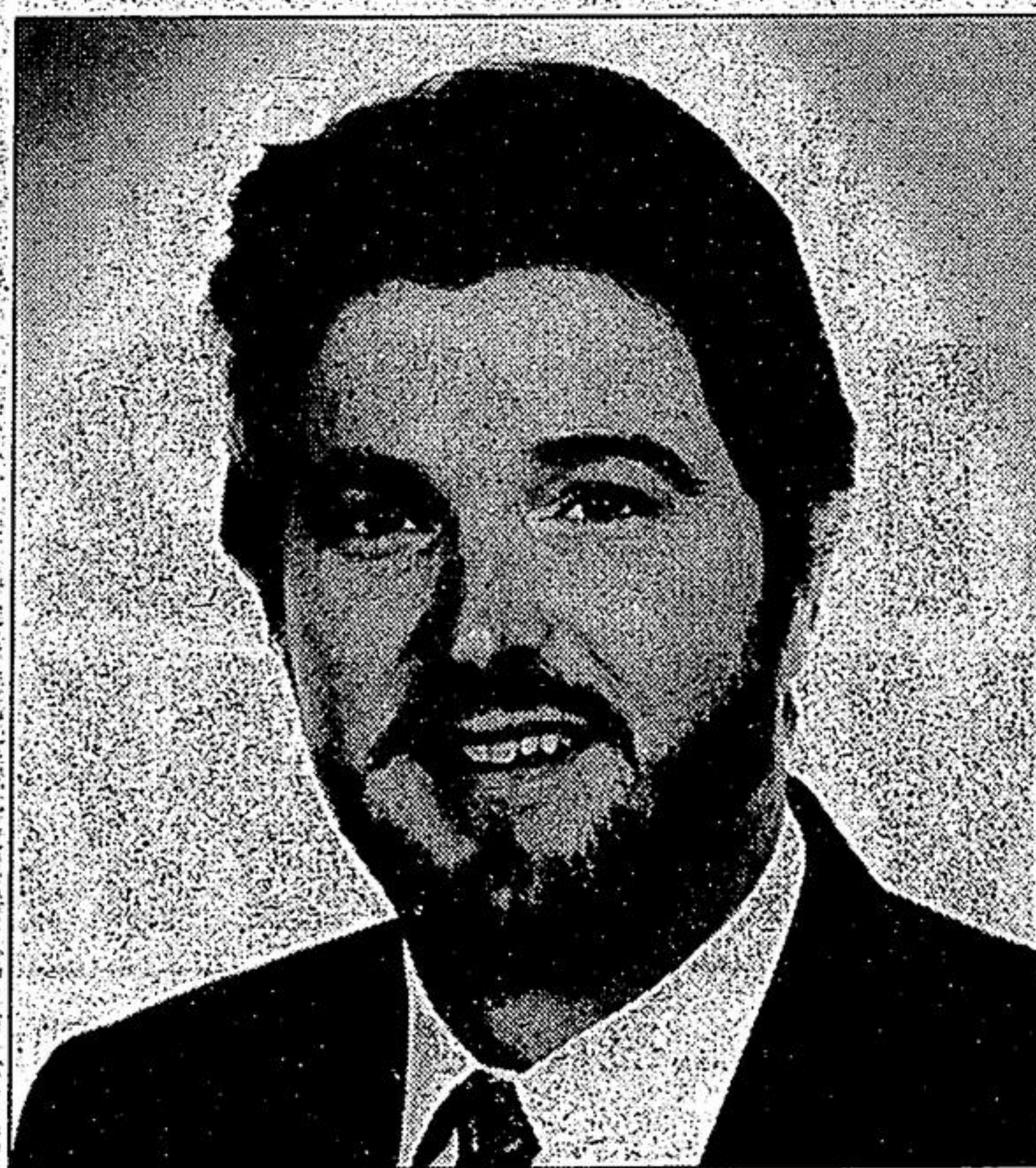
