FINDING A NEW LANDFILL SITE: THE NEXT STEP

The search for a new landfill site to serve the residents of the Region of Durham is a difficult job. The provincial government has established a government authority, the Interim Waste Authority (IWA), to find three environmentally-suitable landfills to meet the long-term waste disposal needs of the Greater Toronto Area, which includes the Region of Durham.

The search began last August when the IWA released its first document outlining the proposed criteria for the site search. During the public consultation period, the IWA received wide-ranging views and opinions about the planned process.

Following public comment, the IWA is now releasing the revised criteria prior to the preparation of any long list of potential landfill sites.

Called *Revised Approach and Criteria (Steps 1-4), Supplemental Criteria (Steps 5-6)*, and referred to as Environmental Assessment Document II, Part 1, this document includes additional and new criteria. It is now available to the public for a minimum review period of 60 days. It contains:
