Designed along the lines of a Third World market, A World of Goods deals exclusively in goods produced by disabled people in developing countries. In this way, the store is an extension of CBMI's work of rehabilitation among disabled men and women overseas. Through CBMI's stores, capable and talented artisans are able to find a profitable market for their crafts.



## PEPPERCORNS

Pepper, the most popular spice in North America, is native to the monsoon forest of the Malabar Coast in India. According to many historians, the demand for pepper provided the main impetus for the discovery by the explorer Vasco de Gama of a sea route from Europe to India.

There are four types of peppercorns - black, white, green and pink - and all of them come from the same plant. Black peppercorns are picked unripe and allowed to dry in the sun. White peppercorns are picked ripe, soaked in water, the outer skin rubbed off and then allowed to dry until they turn white. Green peppercorns are picked immature and are preserved by freeze drying. The most expensive and the most delicate of all is the pink variety. The berries remain in the plant until they are fully ripened and turn pink. They have a brittle outer shell enclosing a small seed and taste aromatic, rather than pungent.
