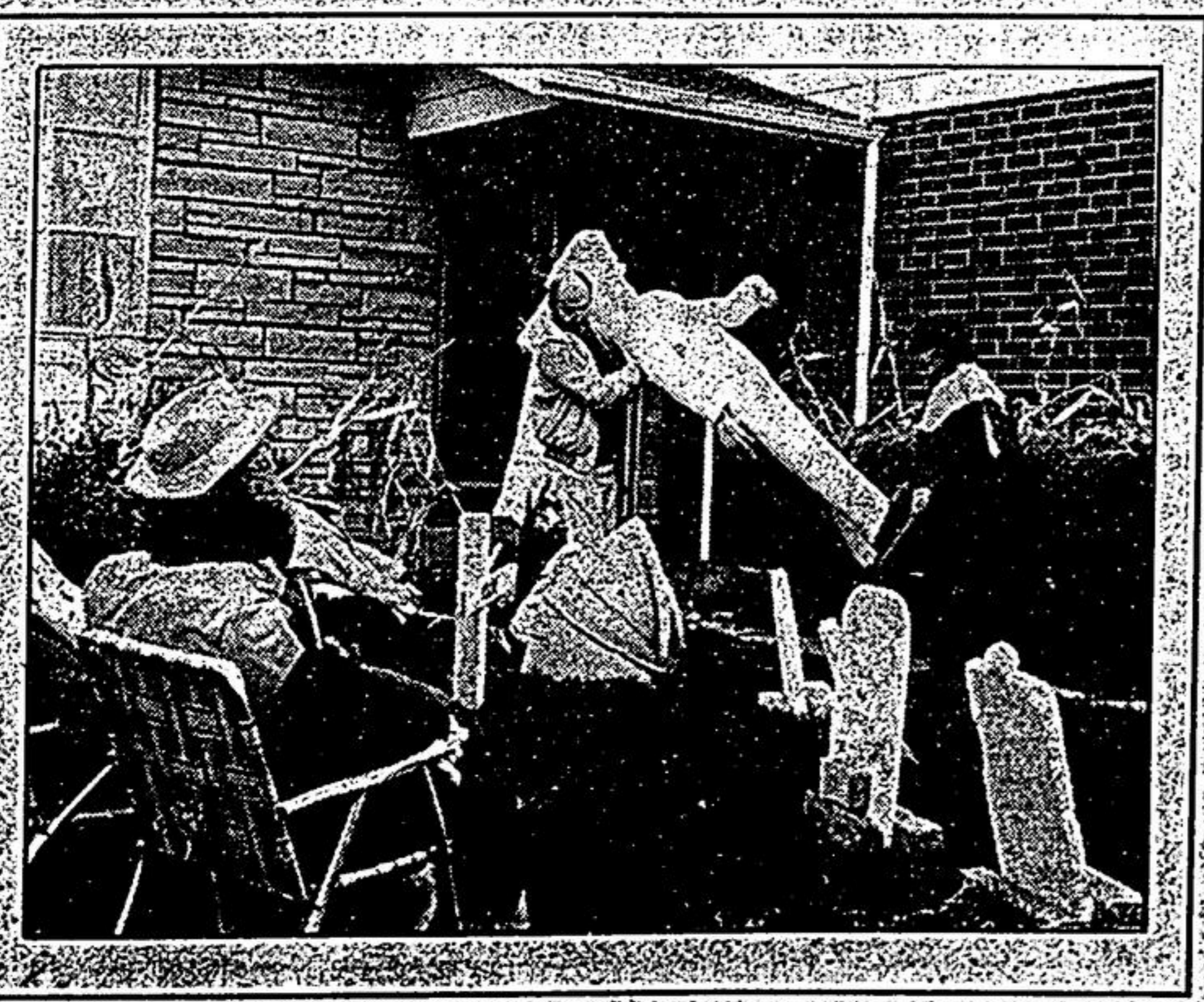
HALLOWEEN in STOUFFVILLE
