

Derry off to national triathlon finals

Stouffville resident Dave Derry will compete with the Ontario and Canadian triathlon teams based on his performance in a national and provincial team qualifier held recently at Guelph. Derry, 45, finished second in the 45-49 age group. He was 125th overall in a field of over 500 entrants in the event,

which included a 1 1/2-mile kilometre swim, a 40-km cycle and a 10-km run. Derry will travel to Calgary with the Ontario triathlon team for the national championships July 25, then will be with the Canadian squad that contests the world championships in Manchester, England on Aug. 22.

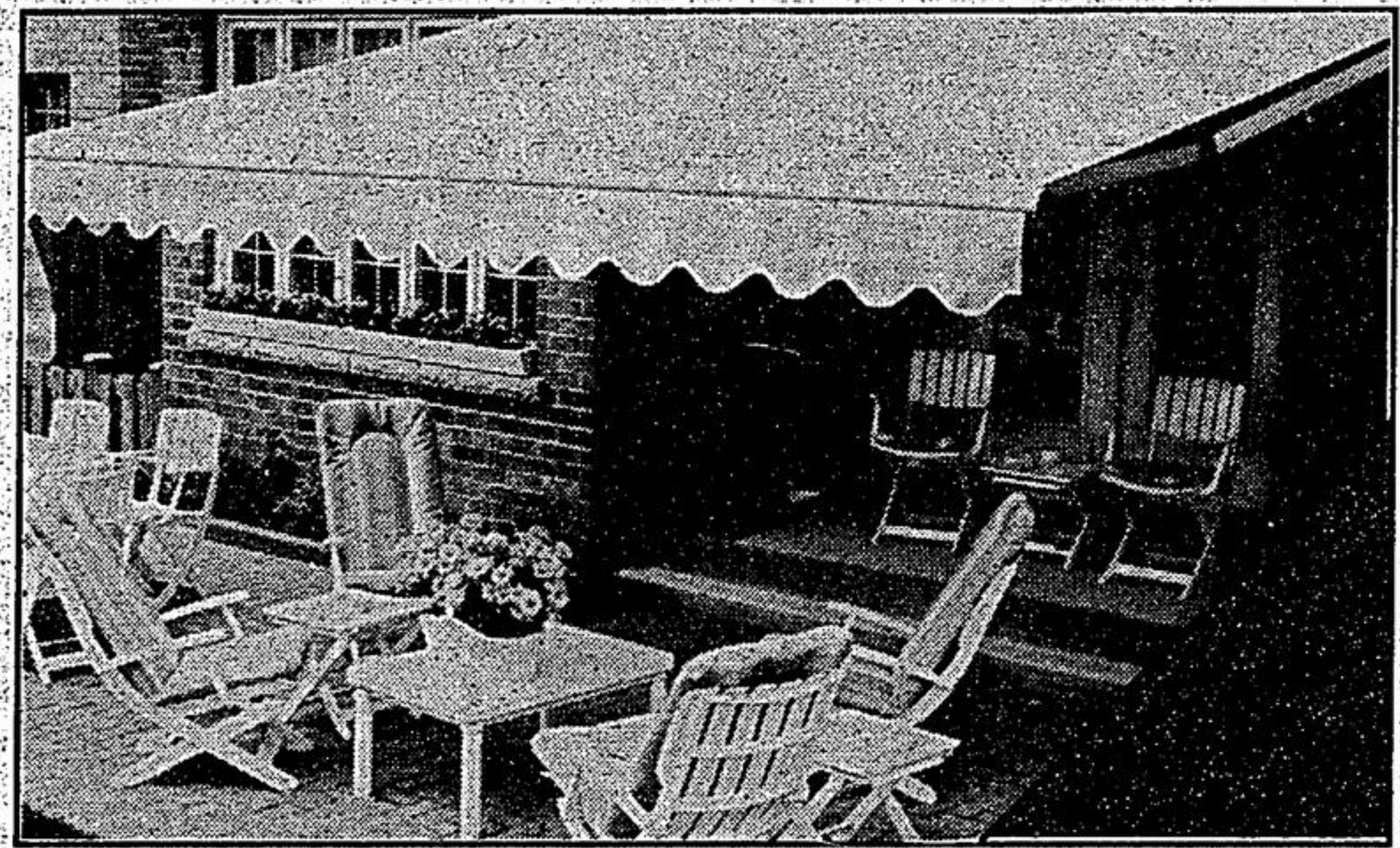
