Farm Guide

Farm safety tips for kids

Farm children live in a workplace that exposes them to heavy machinery, dangerous chemicals, livestock, and numerous other hazards.

Almost 15 per cent of farm accident victims are under 10 years of age. It is the adult's responsibility to ensure youngsters are isolated from risk.

Accidents involving children can be prevented through attention to details, and a sound understanding of fundamental safety principles:

- Ensure equipment and buildings are safe. Hazardous situations must be isolated. Children are extremely curious but lack adult judgment. They may also be small enough to get past protective devices that would stop most grown-ups. Diligence is of the utmost importance.

- Keep pesticides in a locked storage area and use with due caution around children.

- Know where children are at all times. This, while difficult if both parents have to join in the work, is essential to their well being and safety.

- Practise safety. Have you ever left a chemical container for "just a second," and ended up coming back several hours later? The best planning and intentions only pay off if safety is practised every day.

- Educate. Small children can learn the rudiments of safety, such as which areas of the farm are "off limits." As they get older, kids can learn why certain things are dangerous. School programs and safety publications designed specifically for children enhance the learning process.

Remember that children sometimes are careless, forgetful or disobedient.

In the end, the safety of children on the farm is in your hands.

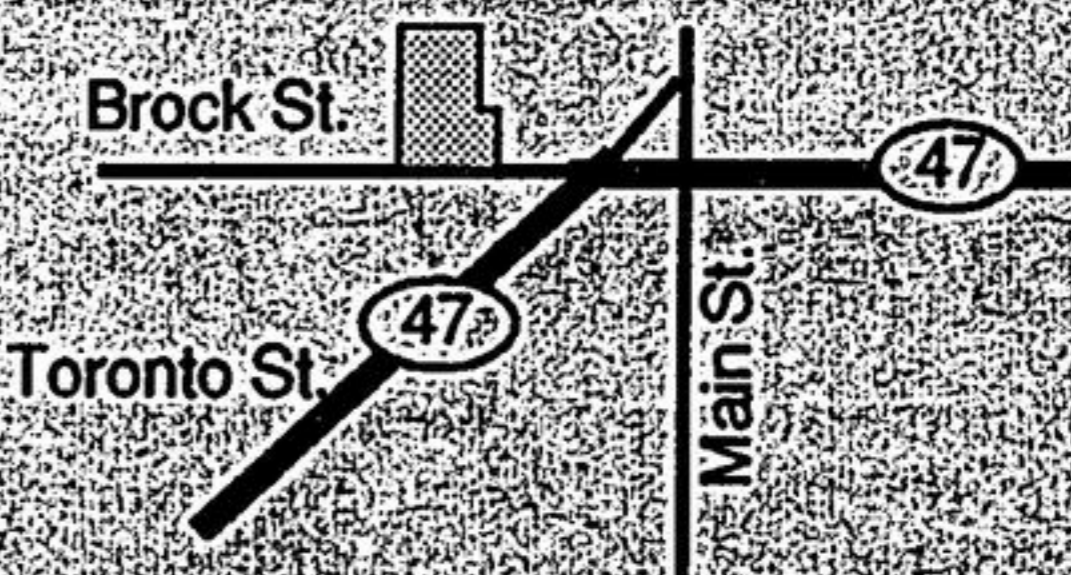
