MUSEUM NEWS

Whitchurch-Stouffville Museum presents its 20th annual Antique and Classic Car Show on Woodbine Ave., north of the Bloomington Sideroad in Vandorf, Sunday, Aug. 8 from 11 a.m. to 4 p.m. "Our biggest event was the year before last, when we had 250 antique cars," said museum curator Andrea Wilson. "This year we're aiming for 225 to 250, and we'll have activities for the whole family, so even if only one family member is into cars, the rest can enjoy it as well." York-Durham Heritage Railway will be on site, featuring train rides for youngsters, and the museum will also feature a rope maker, who will make skipping ropes for children. "They can help make them too," said Wilson. As well, a blacksmith will demonstrate metal work and the historical buildings in the grounds will be open. Young students can take a trip back in time in the school room, where they can sit at the antique desks and use the slates their forebears once used.

An exhibition of community groups and clubs in Whitchurch-Stouffville will be on display in the basement and there will be a barbecue and tearoom open during the day. "There'll be children's games at about 2 p.m. and at 12:30 we're going to have a magician, Rick Mallet, who will be doing a magic show." Admission is \$4 each or \$10 for a family of four. Children under 7 will be admitted free of charge. The rain date is Aug. 15.

The museum is running a children's heritage holiday program from Aug. 18 to 20. "We're doing a number of heritage crafts and activities including candle making, paper crafts, flower crafts and quilting," advised Wilson. To

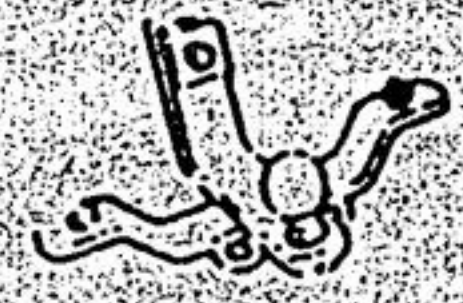
