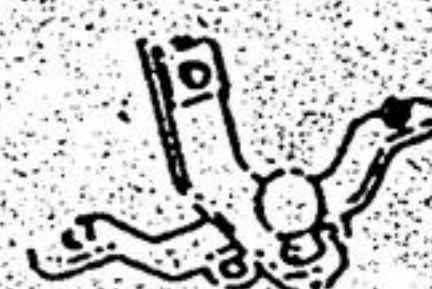

1st Instalment Due - August 20, 1993
 2nd Instalment Due - October 22, 1993

FINAL tax bills have now been mailed. Ratepayers who have not received their bills should make immediate application to the Municipal Tax Department.

The PENALTY charged for non-payment of 1993 taxes is one and one quarter (1-1/4) percent imposed on the first day of default and on the first day of each month thereafter.

Failure to receive a tax bill does not eliminate the responsibility for payment of taxes nor the penalty charges for late payment.
