**Information Notice**

The Town of Markham is undertaking environmental management studies for four subwatersheds in the northern portion of Markham, including Bruce, Burdenett, Robinson, and Exhibition Creeks. In addition, municipal servicing (sanitary and water) studies are being undertaken. The studies will establish requirements for portions of development recommended in the Town of Markham Urban Expansion Study, which established the Town's urban limits to the year 2011 and beyond.
