YORK-DURHAM ON TRACK:

York-Durham Heritage Railway Association has been busy refurbishing the passenger car it transported from the city to Uxbridge earlier this year.

The association is extremely grateful for the support and practical help it has received from many people in the community, said YDHRA president Rob Pare.

Last week the passenger car was sandblasted by Terry of S and T Sandblasting of Claremont, and re-painted by Todd Stoltz of Stouffville, using special heavy-duty automotive paint supplied by Duncan Giles of Giles Chev-Olds in Stouffville.

The paint is an olive green similar to the color originally used by Canadian National Railways for their passenger trains.

The YDHRA logo is being produced by Dean Nolan of Markham Signs and a member of the association has acquired a sufficient number of seats to fill two passenger cars, since YDHRA is hoping to add a second car to its collection through CN in the future.

Dave and Chris Brune of Four Square Construction in Uxbridge have been renewing and replacing the windows on the car, with lumber supplied by Joe Sorino, advised Pare.

Meanwhile, YDHRA continues to offer children's rides on its authentic model railway at events across York and Durham regions to raise awareness and funds for the association.

The railway was on site during Steam Threshing Days at Uxbridge-Scott Museum last weekend and will be operating at the following venues this fall: Uxbridge Fall Fair, Bruce's Mill Harvest Fest and the Pine Ridge Railway Show in Whitby. YDHRA urgently needs volunteers and welcomes new members.
