Stouffville youth charged after pellet gun shooting

Five people were shot at Sunday afternoon in Stouffville. Three boys, ages 10 and 11, and two women, 21 and 64, were walking or biking along 10th Line when shots were fired from a house near the flea market between noon and 1:20 p.m. The two women were hit with slugs from the powerful pellet gun, one on the right cheek and the other on the upper thigh. The injuries are minor, police said. Three teens were taken into custody. Two 14 year olds were released unconditionally while a third boy was arrested. The Stouffville youth is charged with mischief endangering life, possession of an offensive weapon, three counts of pointing a firearm, four counts of wounding with a firearm and two counts of assault with a weapon.


