
place at the annual Markham Fair. While canvassing for donations, community and hospital volunteers will provide residents with information about the hospital. In support of this campaign, the Council of the Town of


opportunity to clear potentially dangerous waste out of your home, and protect our environment - water, land and air - at the same time. If hazardous products are thrown in the regular garbage, they can injure sanitation workers and

cause long-term environmental problems. Bring your Household Hazardous Waste to one of the special depots, and it will be dealt with by experts, at no cost to you.


**What to do:**

1. Look under your kitchen and bathroom sinks, in the medicine cabinet, tool shed, garage and basement. You'll probably find all kinds of cleaners, waxes, detergents, cosmetics, expired prescriptions, solvents, paints, bug killers, oil and grease, etc.
2. Make sure all materials are in original containers or contents are very well marked on containers. Be sure that all containers are capped. Please remember that your containers must be deposited with waste materials and are not returnable.
3. Bring your Household Hazardous Wastes to one of the locations shown below.
