

# Stouffville set for Sunday's Terry Fox Run

Stouffville will help keep the dream alive this Sunday (Sept. 19) as the town takes part in the 13th annual Terry Fox Run for Cancer Research.

Organizers are hoping to see as many as 300 people run, walk, rollerblade, bike, or stroll the 10-kilometre course, which begins and ends at the Rec Centre and winds through the streets on the north side of Main St.

The town will be out to match or surpass last year's total pledges of \$11,623 amassed by 286 participants.

Once again, there will be a Top School Award to the school which raises the most funds.

This year, family members accompanying their children will be added to the respective school total.

The emphasis is on family participation, with everyone from kids to seniors being encouraged to get involved.

According to organizer Sandy Schell-Kennedy, the idea is to focus on what each individual can do to support the innovative cancer research made possible by the over \$100 million raised since the initial Terry Fox Run in 1981.

"Cancer strikes every

one, and Stouffville has lost some very big people to cancer," said Schell-Kennedy.

"But Stouffville also has people like Bill Murphy, Jeremy Schell, and Sally Gyton who have survived cancer due to the research that's being done, and they are willing to help the cause."

Schell said Murphy and Gyton planned to run or walk the course this year, while four year old Jeremy

Schell will attempt to ride his bike.

In previous years, he rode on the back of his mom or dad's bike.

All three are Terry's Team Members, people who have had cancer and have proved that research works.

The run is scheduled to go from 1-5 p.m. There will be water stations along the 10 km route.

T-shirts, hats, and buttons depicting Terry Fox and cancer researchers will be available for purchase.

Volunteers are welcome

to assist with the run. Pledge forms are available at Schell Lumber, the Stouffville Library, local schools, or by calling Sandy Schell-Kennedy at 640-4705.
