

ST Midget high school hoop program is restructured

It's goodbye midget boys' basketball, along with tennis, golf and skiing as the new athletic year gets under way at Stouffville District Secondary School.

Dave Connell, Stouffville District Secondary School boys' physical education head, says the midget boys' hoops program has been

dropped in York Region due to the cost of hiring referees and bussing. "There will be a midget houseleague set up in the school, with a tournament to be held near the end of the season," said Connell.

The school decided to cancel its annual tennis, golf and downhill

skiing programs due to financial reasons, and the fact that all three are essentially non-instructional, non-team sports.

"The teachers who coach these programs haven't really been coaching, they've been more like supervisors," said Connell.

Runners place in road races

Stouffville runner Fred Robbins brought home a pair of gold medals for finishing first in his age class in two recent road races.

Robbins was first in the 30-39 class, and second overall, with a time of 34 minutes and 18 seconds, at a 10-kilometre event in Brampton on Aug. 22.

He won his age class again at the six-km. Sunset Shuffle in Toronto on Aug. 31.

Robbins was sixth overall with a time of 19:44. Stouffville's Dave Reed was third overall with a time of 19:23.

Larry Fockler posted a personal best of 36:24 in the race, good for 13th place overall.

Kim Kavluk ran a personal best of 36:19, good for fourth place in

his age class and 10th overall at the Sauble Beach 10K event on Aug. 14.

Fockler also contested the event, and was fifth in his age class and 12th overall with a personal best time of 36:42.

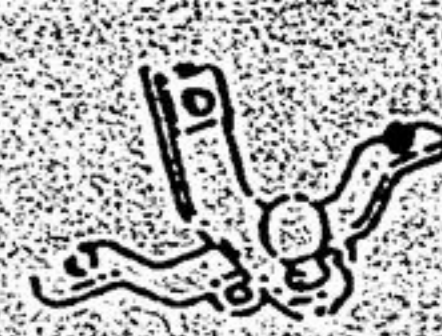

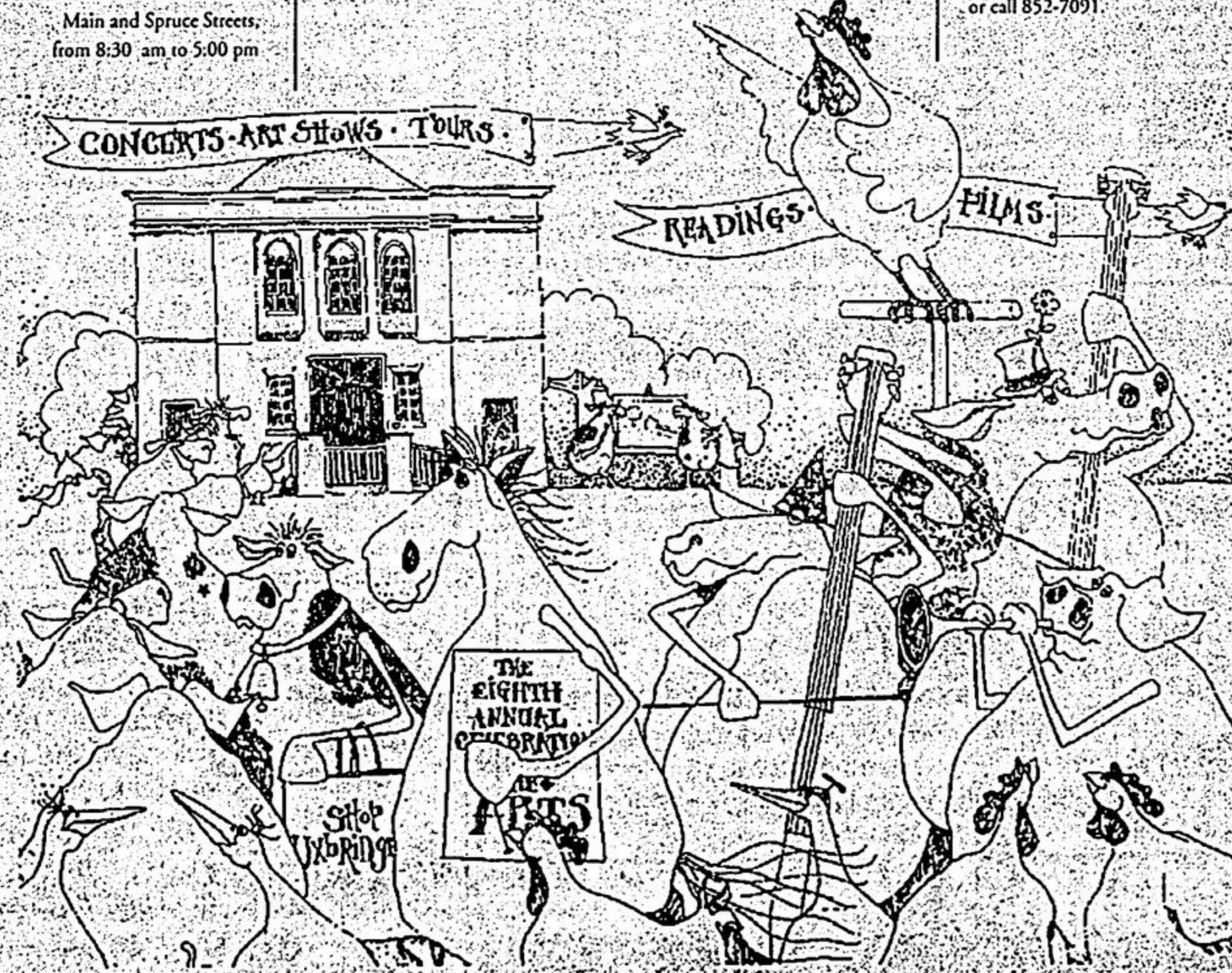
