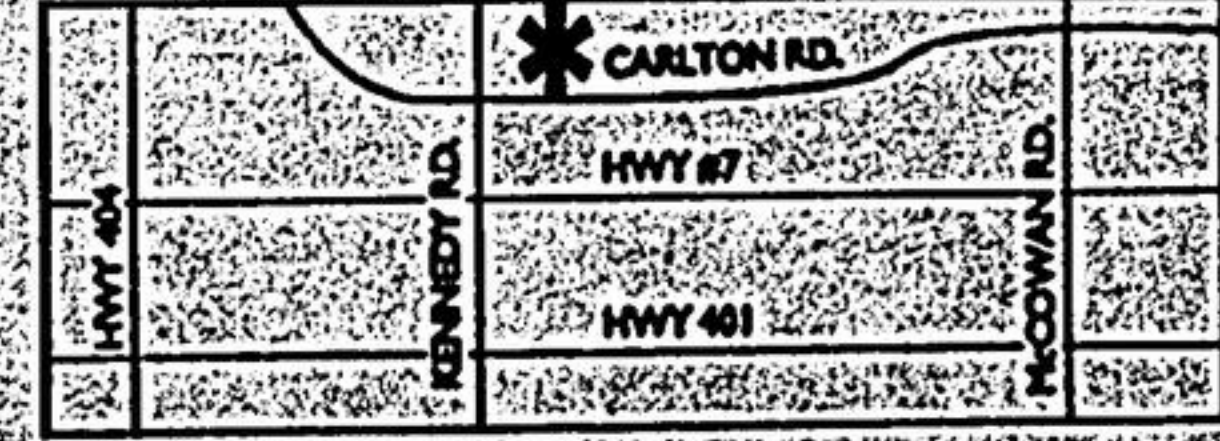
The same attention to the minutest detail is taken with all the foods prepared in small batches in the Village Grocer kitchen - soups, savoury sauces, quiches, their
