We of the Whitchurch-Stouffville Mobility Transit Steering Committee would like to thank through your newspaper the members of council individually and as a whole for accepting the recommendation we made at the council meeting on Sept. 21.

Thank you for endorsing our proposal to operate a pilot project for one year.

We will provide the service of a contracted accessible taxi to be used by those who are eligible.

Thank you for listening to us through the past three and a half years as we have conducted surveys, chosen a logo, formed an eligibility committee, researched data, and revised strategies.

In the past you have listened to spokespeople for the disabled and have responded by encouraging businesses to become accessible, you have cut curbs to assist the mobility of all; you have provided walkways where wheel chairs and scooters can move more freely and you have located or re-

located handicapped parking locations in more convenient places.

Now you are making it possible so that those disabled people who previously had limited means of travelling within our community will soon be able to reach the streets where the curbs are cut and enter the places of business that are accessible.

They will be able to plan their own appointments and become more independent. Caregivers will be relieved of a portion of their responsibilities.

Thank you for caring for these people who are an impor-

tant portion of our community. Thank you for placing your faith in us as we continue to work together on this pilot project.

Thank you for making it possible for Mobility Transit to become a reality within Whitchurch-Stouffville.
