the top position earlier this summer.

Hogarth's four-year agreement started July 1 with an annual salary of between \$125,000 and \$135,000. He has the use of a full

size four door automobile including insurance, as well as health benefits and life insurance and five weeks plus five days vaca-

tion. He has a stake in the board's sick leave plan through which an employee can accumulate up to 300 sick days. On retirement, Hogarth will receive a gratuity equivalent to six months salary based on his salary at the time.

The deal contains a clause of automatic renewal for another four years to extend the contract until July 30, 2001. Since taking over as director, Hogarth has made changes from where he sits at the board table to where he parks his car. The director has

chosen to sit with his staff near the public instead of at the head of the board table.

"It's a matter of responding more directly to the board," he said, adding it allows him to have eye contact with the board chair. And all the designated parking spaces for staff have been removed from the Aurora headquarters.

"The privilege should go to the community. I'm no different than anyone else who serves the public. I can walk just as well as anyone."
