**PUBLIC NOTICE**  
**SIDEWALK AND WINDROW SNOW-CLEARING SERVICE FOR SENIORS AND PHYSICALLY CHALLENGED RESIDENTS**

This winter season, the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville will again provide a residential sidewalk and windrow snow-clearing service for seniors and physically challenged residents of the municipality. The snow windrow is the snow bank across the driveway left by the road snowplow.

The Public Works Department will clear the public sidewalk fronting on the property and the snow windrow from the driveways of residents who meet the eligibility criteria and who submit completed application forms for the service.

The Eligibility Criteria for the sidewalk and windrow snow-clearing service are as follows:

- "This service is available to Whitchurch-Stouffville residents who: (a) are over sixty-five (65) years of age and physically unable to shovel snow or (b) are of any age and who are disabled and can provide a medical certificate to prove such ability. (c) fulfill either (a) or (b) and have no other able bodied persons living in the home.

Application forms are available by mail from the Public Works Department by calling 640-1900 or 895-2423; or can be picked up at the Municipal Office, Recreation Complex and at the Public Library in Stouffville.

**Completed application forms should be returned to the Municipal Offices before Friday, November 12th, 1993.**
