

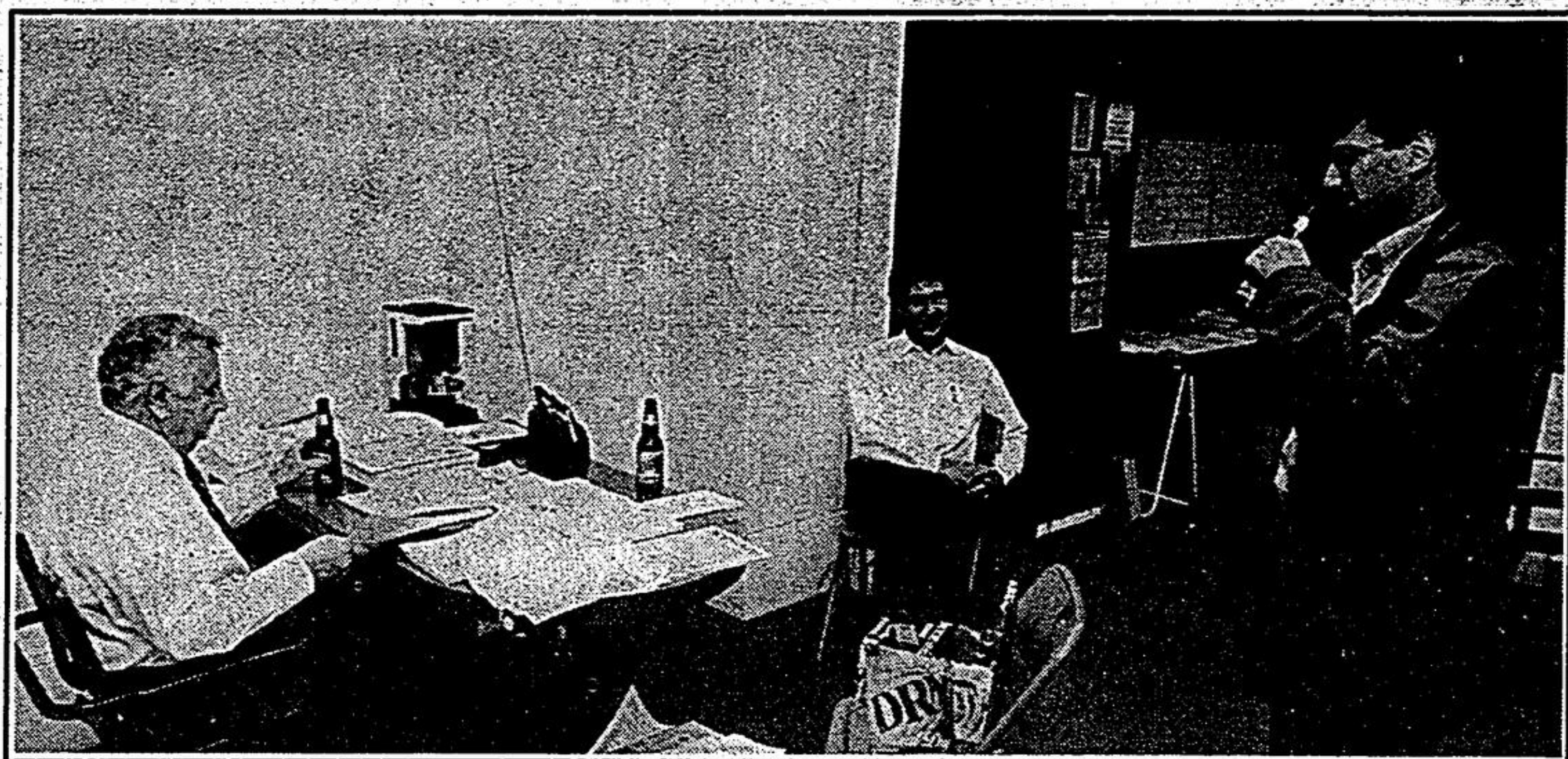

which swept the country. "The writing was on the wall for them after Mulroney left and Kim Campbell came out with a negative campaign that didn't offer any jobs or policies."

He stressed the Liberals would follow through on their campaign promises. "I promise that the promises we made in this election will be kept. The promise to create jobs, to maintain medicare; these will be kept."

He said this riding, with its mix of farmland, subdivisions, corporate offices and multi-racial population, is unique in Canada and he promised to ensure that it is given special attention by Ottawa.

"We are the new Canada, that's what you are seeing tonight," he said in an interview after his speech. "We need a person who will go and say we are a special riding."

Bhaduria said he had excellent support from the party at all levels. "The Liberal heavyweights came out for this campaign," he said. "Senator Keith Davey was here, Greg Sorbarra and Clyde Wells. I don't think you can get a much more prominent Liberal than Clyde Wells, that was the icing on the cake."

nothing is certain. "I'd say we're quietly confident," she said before local results started coming in.

"But there's always this little kerchunk in the pit of your stomach. Nothing is 100 per cent sure."

While there was much talk of Reform stealing Conservative votes, Gilmore said many disgruntled Tories that phoned the Bhaduria campaign office chose to vote Liberal.

"Some of that vote obviously went to the Reform, but an awful lot went to us."

The botched Tory campaign and voter resentment over the past eight years of Conservative government also took a heavy toll on incumbent Bill Attewell, said Gilmore.
