

Cabletech growing steadily, despite recession

to organize the orders, so I took that job over from the foreman," said Miller.

Miller pointed to the company's determination to stay abreast of up-to-date technology as being a major reason why Cabletech has been able to compete against the bigger Canadian wire and cable companies.

"The technology has changed drasti-

cally. It's far more sophisticated today. For instance, we were the first company in North America to produce continuous cast copper. Everyone's gone to it now."

Miller said the most difficult part of expanding has been getting employees to share knowledge which had only been needed by themselves through the years. "The biggest problem was to

learn to let go and to delegate. In the past, so much of what was used was in people's heads. But you have to start writing things down so everyone has access to that knowledge."

At the top, Cabletech president Ernie Reynolds points with pride to the fact his company has withstood the current recession, and is now on the move again. He attributes that to a policy of

quality control whereby employees and management have worked together to maintain the company's competitive edge.

"We had a downturn for a while in 1990-91," he conceded.

"But by mid 1991, we started out of it, and we've been growing strongly ever since. While all the others are hurting, we're flourishing."



MONDAY, JULY 26, 1993

&

MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 20, 1993

The THIRD INSTALMENT of the 1993 Final Tax Bill is due and payable on

MONDAY, NOVEMBER 1, 1993

Payments must be received in the Town Office or paid at the bank on or before the due date to avoid penalty and/or interest charges. IN ORDER FOR YOUR PAYMENT TO ARRIVE ON OR BEFORE THE DUE DATE, BE SURE TO MAIL IT AT LEAST SEVEN (7) DAYS PRIOR TO THE DUE DATE.


