### POPPY REPORT FORM

The General By-Laws of the Ontario Command state:  
 (a) Where a Branch fails to submit a Poppy Report Form by October 31st each year covering its activities from October 1st of the previous year to September 30th of the current year, it shall forfeit the right to hold future Poppy Campaigns.  
 (b) Notwithstanding the foregoing, a Branch which has forfeited the right to hold a Campaign shall have the right to appeal to the Administrative Council.  
 The District Poppy Committee will determine if the Report Form is to be submitted direct to the Command or through your Zone Poppy Chairman.
