

CAO clarifies stand on batching plants

Dear Editor,

The Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville wishes to clarify its position and correct information printed in a recent front page article in *The Tribune* dealing with batching plants.

The town is extremely concerned that the potential exists for the degradation of the aquifer(s) serving area wells and in the case of St. Mary's Cement the municipal water supply to Stouffville residents.

Whether this degradation is in the form of concrete ad-mixture contamination, the diverting of and drawing upon the leachate plume from the closed landfill site north of Bloomington Sideroad, the accumulative effect of this operation in conjunction with other existing impacts, or some other yet unknown source, protecting the water supply to the community of Stouffville is of paramount importance.

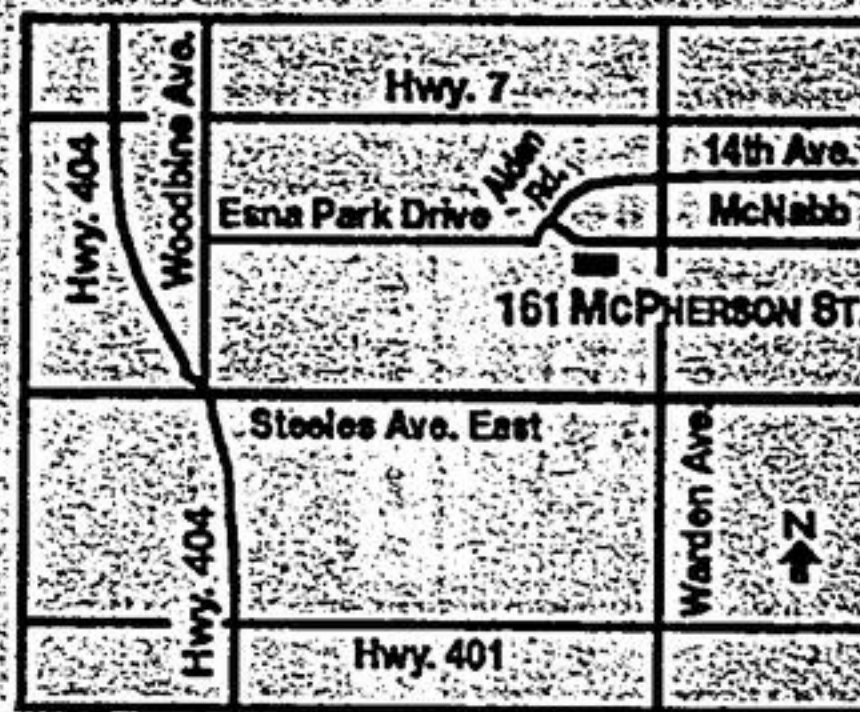

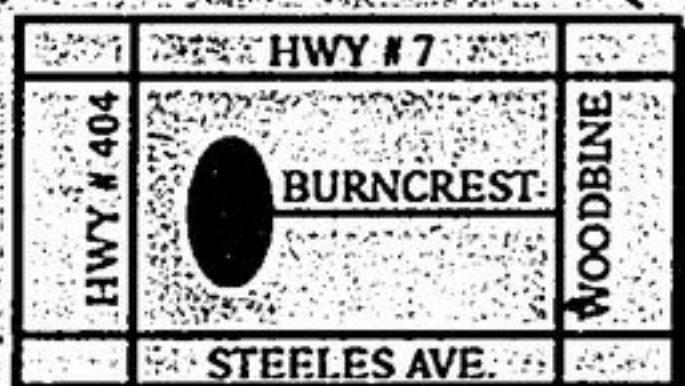

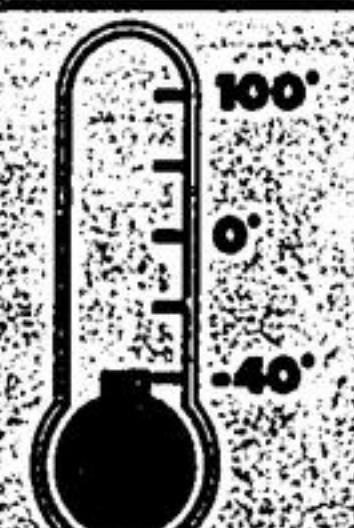
