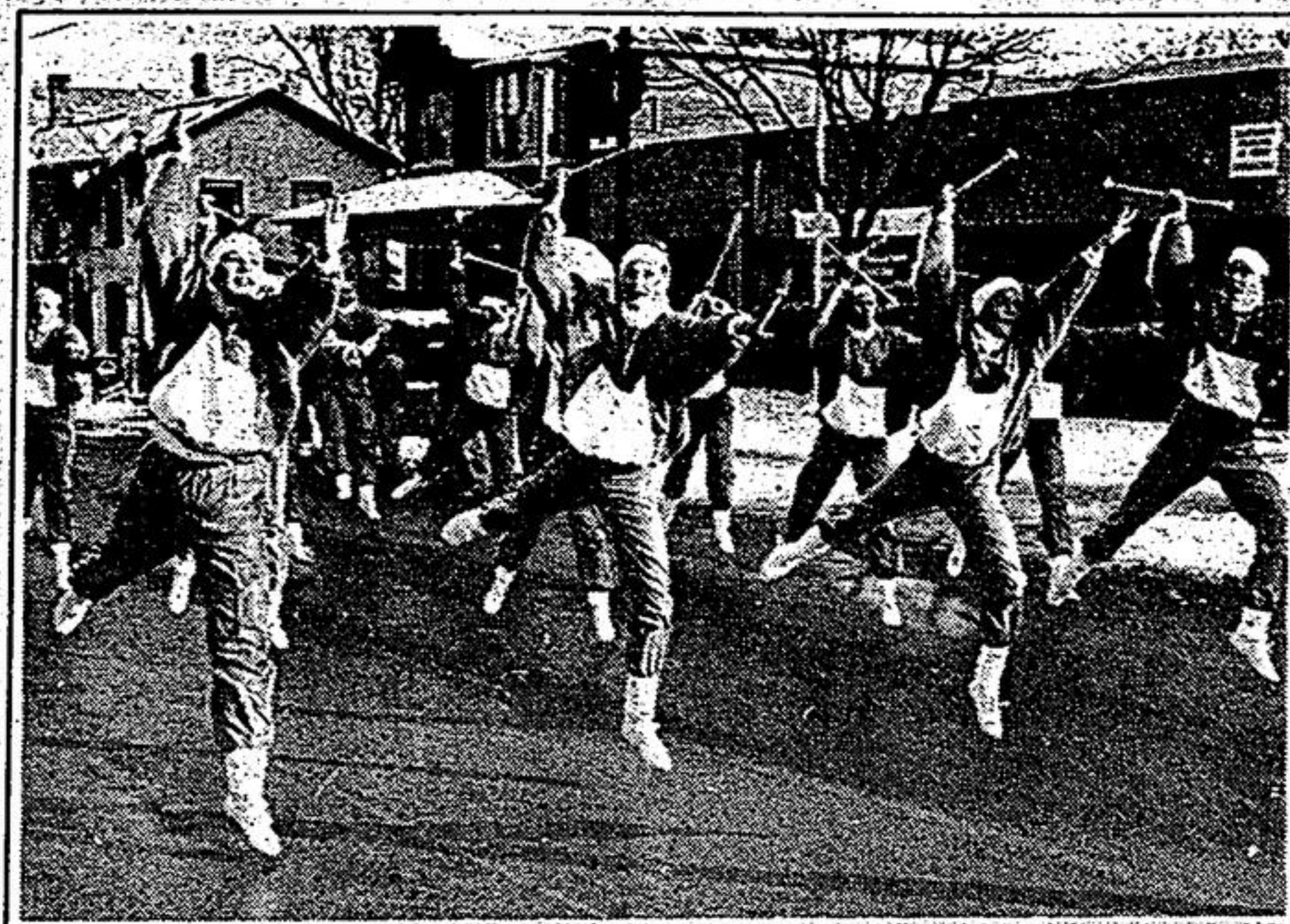
from 1 to 101 - Santa Claus is coming to town Dec. 4 at 2 p.m.
